Davies High School announces the hiring of head coaches for girls cross county, boys soccer and volleyball teams.

Tyler Carlson has been named the head coach for girls cross country. Coach Carlson was an assistant for boys' cross country at Fargo South High School in 2011, then the head boy's cross-country coach from 2012-13. In 2014, he was named the first head boys cross country coach and head boys track and field coach at Sheyenne High School. Carlson graduated from MSUM with a degree in Physical Education in 2014 and spent eight years teaching PE in West Fargo Public Schools. He will join the Davies teaching staff in the fall of 2023 in the physical education department.

Coach Carlson states "I feel very lucky, and fortunate, to have the opportunity to coach the girls, cross country team at Davies High School. The culture that has been created here is really second to none. That culture, and tradition of excellence, is something I'm very excited to be a part of."

"Tyler will be a great addition to our teaching and coaching staff. He has experience and passion for the sport of cross country and education" states Lenny Ohlhauser, Davies Activities Director.

Adam Haskins has been named the head coach for boys' soccer. Haskins has been an assistant coach for four different programs, totaling 16 seasons. Most recently, he was a part of the West Fargo Packers girls' program and Concordia College men's program. In 2021 he was a finalist for Assistant Coach of the year for boys' soccer in Minnesota. When not coaching soccer, he works for the City of West Fargo. He also enlisted into the Air National Guard and did one tour to Bagram, Afghanistan, in 2012.

Coach Haskins says, "I look forward to coaching and mentoring student athletes both on and off the field, along with maintaining the culture of success and hard work that Davies Athletics has been instilling into all their programs."

Ohlhauser states, "Adam has great experience in both the boys' and girls' soccer programs. Through the multiple experiences at different levels, it will be exciting to see him bring his skill set to the head coaching position and lead our boys' soccer program."
