The students and staff at Eagles raised the money for the donation with a penny war last week. Each class competed to see which class could raise the most money in their jars. Miss Anderson's class won the penny war by raising \$211.30 and earned the right to present the donation to Fillipi and a special ice cream treat.

It provides furnishings, décor, and other items to people transitioning out of homelessness feel at home in their new lodgings. Down Home has helped furnish homes for multiple Eagles families this school year.
