The senior class at South High School will head back to their pasts and visit five elementary schools to reflect on their journey to graduation and dedicate themselves to activities benefitting the next generation of Bruins as part of their Senior P.R.A.N.K. (People Really Appreciate Nice Kids) Day in the morning on Tuesday. They will then head back to the high school for the senior scholarship ceremony, enjoy the present moment of each other's company at the senior class barbecue, and close the day by looking ahead to their futures with the Celebrate Your Future event.

At 8:45 a.m., the seniors will either walk to Lewis & Clark Elementary School or travel by bus to Clara Barton, Eagles, Ed Clapp, Jefferson, and Lincoln Elementary Schools, where they will do a graduation walk and engage the elementary students in a variety of activities in and out of the classroom.

The seniors will return to South for their senior scholarship ceremony to recognize the seniors who have been granted college scholarships. A senior class barbecue will follow at lunch time.

After lunch, the seniors will participate in games and activities on the football field during the Celebrate Your Future event. The school has invited representatives from local colleges to celebrate with the seniors and will recognize students taking all paths after graduation, whether they are attending college, joining the military, or entering the workforce.

Activities will include a tug-of-war between students attending North Dakota State University vs. those attending the University of North Dakota with a travelling trophy awarded to the winning team, an athletic contest for those entering the military, a career-focused relay race, a trivia contest, and a senior class picture.
