Davies High School seniors are headed out to five Fargo Public Schools elementary schools where they will don their caps and gowns and participate in graduation celebrations on Wednesday to reconnect with their pasts and inspire the elementary students.

During the celebrations the seniors will spend some time interacting with the elementary students and then walk through the halls of the elementary school in their caps and gowns while the younger students and staff line the hallways to celebrate them.

The seniors will depart from Davies on one of two buses, each of which will visit two elementary schools. One bus will visit Ed Clapp Elementary School and Centennial Elementary School while the other will visit Eagles Elementary School and Bennett Elementary School. Celebrations will begin at Ed Clapp and Eagles 9:20 a.m. and celebrations at Centennial and Bennett will be at 10:30 a.m. Another group of students will meet at Kennedy Elementary School for a celebration at 10:30 a.m.
