Though they compete against each other to cross the finish line first during the fall, the South and Davies cross country teams are teaming up to raise funds and benefit a peer with cancer this Thursday.

The two teams are coming together to host a carwash and bake sale fundraiser from noon to 6 p.m. Thursday at the Family Fare Supermarket on 25th Street South in Fargo. The bake sale funds will be donated to South freshman cross country runner Clara Motschenbacher, who was diagnosed with cancer this spring.

Each year the teams host a fundraiser and donate the bake sale funds to a local community member in need. This year, recognizing a teammate in need of help, they opted to donate the funds to Motschenbacher. Motschenbacher plans to attend the fundraiser for awhile and help wash some cars.
