

7.6 *Dual Enrollment*

Any high school student in grades 10 through 12 may take dual enrollment college courses and receive high school credit in accordance with the regulations of the Alabama State Department of Education. Any student seeking enrollment in a dual enrollment college course will meet the requirements established by the Alabama State Department of Education and the applicable postsecondary institution.

If a particular dual enrollment course is not offered at a student's high school but is offered at another Board high school ("the offering Board high school"), the student will be allowed to take the dual enrollment course, provided course registration is not full, at the offering Board high school through either in-person or virtual means of instruction. For any student who is interested in a dual enrollment course that is not offered at the student's school or at another Board school, the student's school will recommend other, available dual enrollment courses for the student to participate in.

The Superintendent will ensure that, prior to the student course registration period, an information session is held that covers what dual enrollment courses are, the importance of dual enrollment courses, the cost of dual enrollment courses, information on any fee waivers or scholarships that are available to participate in such courses, and information on each dual enrollment course offered by the Board. Additionally, the Board will send home with all high school students information on the dual enrollment courses offered by the Board and how to register for such courses.
