SPRING 2020 COVID-19

In response to the executive order issued by the state of Texas, FBCA continued education online for all core classes (English, History, Math, Science, Theology, and World Languages), and grades were assessed in those courses. Electives and fine arts classes did not meet from March-May 2020, and students were given a 4th Quarter grade that averaged the grades of the first three quarters in those classes. No final exams were administered, and semester grades were factored into overall GPA calculations as usual.
