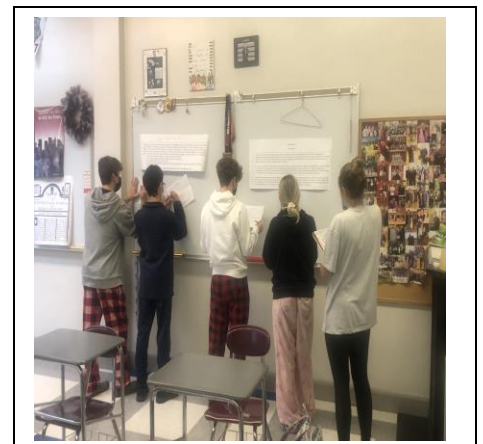
## COMMUNITY AND COLLABORATION

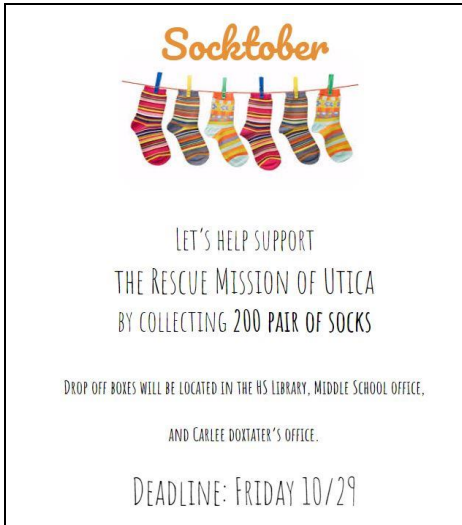
## STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

## FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY

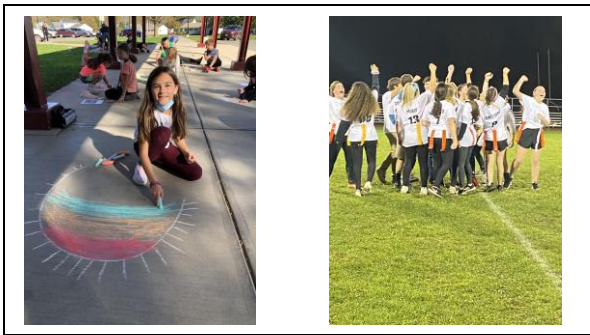
