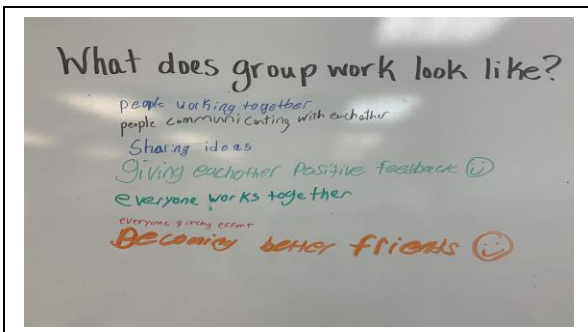
FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY



FSCSD has received a \$3,000 Garden Grant from the Whole Kids Foundation! Our application was selected from over 1,400 applications received from across the U.S. and Canada. Our annual audit has been completed and will be presented to our Board of Education once finalized. The NYS Comptroller's Office has begun their audit, which occurs every 5 years. The district has received and allocated grant funding from various sources to assist with ongoing after school, during school and summer enrichment opportunities.
