






Reading News

We want to celebrate all of the great readers at Heusner! Many students are now 'Word Wizards' as they have mastered all of their phonics skills!





Spring Math Ideas

Egg Hunt-Fill plastic eggs with math problems and spread them throughout the house or yard. Your child can hunt for the eggs and must solve the problem inside each egg in order to keep them.

Jelly Bean Graphing-Jelly beans are a popular spring treat. Have your child sort and graph the different colors in a bag of jellybeans. Then, ask your child questions about his/her completed graph.
