SMART BALANCE TEST RESULTS from previous school year. You can get a copy from your school, district office or student portal (school web account) if you have misplaced your copy. If you are from out of state, you will need the state test scores from that district. State scores must not be lower than 2's or standards nearly met
IEP, 504 or any other accommodations will need to be reviewed. Failure to disclose information when submitting application will result in denial or rescinding of application.

INCOMPLETE PACKETS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Applications must be turned into the U.P. office no later than 3:30pm on April 17th.

Applications will not be accepted between April 18th and May 21st.

Any applications accepted between May 22nd – June 14th will be put to the bottom of the wait list. The U.P. office will be closed for summer break starting June 17th – July 15, 2024.

Priority is defined as a child of a VVUHSD contract employee who meets U.P. criteria

Sibling Priority is defined as a brother or sister of a current UP student (must be in good academic standing) or have graduated from U.P. 2022, 2023 or 2024

District Transfers

Those students who reside outside our district (Victor Valley Union High School District) must have a district transfer from their resident school district. This is permission from their assigned district to attend to ours (VVUHSD). If you do not have this permission, you will be denied entry to VVUHSD. If you live in Adelanto and you are going into high school, you will not need the transfer.

Victor Elementary Students can start the enrollment process to VVUHSD. This is not for University Prep but it will give you a jump start on enrollment for 2024-2025 school year.

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

We appreciate your interest in enrolling your student at University Preparatory. University Preparatory is a public school of choice that requires all of its students to adhere to a strict uniform policy.

Parents/guardians are responsible to provide their own uniform. Dress code specifics will follow once accepted. **Be aware that uniforms may become costly.**

Students are required to take performing arts, instruments will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian. The music teacher will give you information as to where you can rent instruments, if you don't have your own. This information will be given after school is back in session.

We do not have student transportation. You will need to provide your own transportation to and from school.

In order to qualify for the lottery, your student must meet the following guidelines:

- **Applicants for 7th – 9th grade** must have a **G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher (report card will be reviewed for acceptance/eligibility). Absolutely no suspensions or excessive discipline allowed.** **Final** acceptance will be contingent on 3rd trimester or 2nd semester grades and discipline report, you must submit the final report card and discipline report to our office by June 17th. Documents must be submitted in person or by email to lwarnett@vvhhsd.org by July 10th.
- If you are from Victor Elementary, Ms. Warnett will check final discipline.
- **Applicants for 10th – 12th** must have a **G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher and transcripts will be reviewed for eligibility. Absolutely no suspensions or excessive discipline allowed.** **Final** acceptance will be contingent on 2nd semester grades and discipline report, you must submit the final report card and discipline report to our office by June 17th or email the documents to lwarnett@vvhhsd.org by July 10th.
- Minimal or no discipline from previous school(s).
- **ABSOLUTELY NO SUSPENSIONS** (since Jan. 2023)
- 90% positive attendance

HOW TO CALCULATE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL GPA

IF GRADING IS 1-5, ADD ALL THE NUMBERS, DIVIDE BY HOW MANY NUMBERS YOU ADDED, MULTIPLY BY .8 = THE GPA

EXAMPLE: $4+5+3+2+3 = 17$ divide by 5 = 3.4 multiply by .8 = 2.72 GPA

Applicants must meet minimum requirements to be accepted for entrance in the Lottery Pool
(please see attached criteria)

- Lottery pulled applicants for acceptance (2024–2025) will be notified by email or telephone.
- **Final** acceptance for the 2024-2025 school year will be **contingent** upon final grades, discipline and attendance in May/June. Parent will be responsible for providing final grades, discipline and attendance report to University Preparatory office or email it to lwarnett@vvuhsd.org. If there is no discipline to report, you will need a letter confirming this on current school letterhead. Each qualified applicant will be given an application number.
- Each grade level will be separated for their own vacancy pool.
- Principal designee will pull application numbers for each vacancy spot, per grade level, until all spots are filled
- Principal designee will continue to pull applicant numbers for wait list, for each grade level
- Wait list will be posted, by application number, on our website at <https://up.vvuhsd.org/> and in the U.P. office
- Wait list will only be valid for that school year. All applicants not accepted must reapply for the next school year

ADMISSION PRIORITIES/SIBLINGS

1. Siblings of current U.P. students or of siblings who graduated 2022, 2023 or 2024 (siblings must share a common parent, qualified address, including step sibling). This does not include extended family unless guardianship papers have been processed through the court system and are submitted. You may be asked to show proof for priority admission.
2. Children of Victor Valley Union High School District employees. (must show proof by birth certificate)

As a school, we expect students to be **ready** to learn, behave in a **respectful** manner, and take **responsibility** for their actions.
