


UN History

- Replaced the League of Nations formed after WWI with the Treaty of Versailles
- 1942 FDR's Declaration by United Nations with 26 countries to fight Axis Powers during WWII
- June 26, 1945 founded with charter signed by 51 countries
- 193 member countries today


