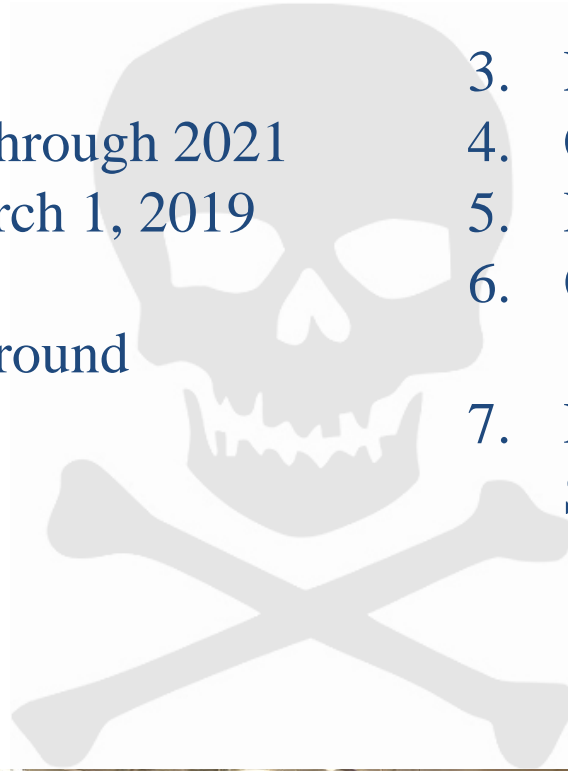

ELIGIBILITY

Residency

- Live with parent/legal guardian
- Enrolled in assigned district
- Not a bona fide move, transfer, or violation – sit out 365 days

Restrictions

- 19 prior to August 31
- 8 Semesters/
4 Seasons





ELIGIBILITY

Previous Semester's

- Grades

Passed 3 Courses

*Seniors enrolled in 3 courses have to pass all 3 courses

*All incoming freshman are eligible for first semester

- Attendance

Less than 10 unexcused days

*No waiver policy

REMOVAL/QUITTING

Removed or athletes that have quit a team are not allowed to participate or join other teams in off season workouts or skills until the season is finished.

Dual sport athletes that are removed or quit one team are also removed from the other team unless the coaches and AD agree.

NCHSAA Definition

Athletes

Quality of responsible behavior characterized by a spirit of generosity and a genuine concern for opponents, officials, and teammates

Ejections

- Competition of NFHS's "Teaching and Modeling Behavior" course
 - Miss next 1 or 2 contests depending on sport
 - Possible school administration discipline

- No money or awards

- Sit out 365 for violation
- Not signed a contract
- Not played on a junior or community college
