OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT SOCIAL STUDIES CLASS GEOGRAPHY:

Throughout the year students will study important events that occurred all over the world. In order to understand these events and how they impact each other students need to know where these places are located. To achieve this knowledge students will have map guizzes of the continents and countries of the world. They will complete reference maps to study. Students will have the following map guizzes:

-Continents and Oceans -North America and Central America -Europe -South America

- Asia -Africa

VOCABULARY:

Understanding the meaning and use of academic vocabulary will help students comprehend the concepts and themes they will study throughout history. On Mondays, students will be given vocabulary lists through Quizlet. Students will copy the words down as part of their "Do Now" and finish them for homework, which will be due the day of the vocab guiz. Students should be studying these terms at home prior to their guizzes. These guizzes will be taken on either Thursday or Friday.

LATE WORK:

Assignments should be turned in on the given due date. Students will only have FIVE days after the assignment due date to submit the assignment. The students will stay during lunch and enrichment during the first five days to complete the assignment. If the late assignment is not turned in after the five day period, students can request an alternate assignment. Please use PowerSchool to keep up with assignments and missing work.
