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## CURRICULUM CORNER

Each month information will be shared about what your child is learning in school. This will be an overview of topics being learned; please contact your child's teacher for more details as needed. If you have special talents or knowledge of a topic to be studied that you would like to share, please reach out to your child's teacher.
We would love for you to share in our students' learning!
Grade 3: In Math, we will wrap up our study of area utilizing the area formula to find an unknown side or unknown area, including solving word problems with area. Then, we will begin our study of fractions! We will use concrete models to identify fractions as part of a whole and part of a set. In ELA, we will extend our study of Japan by reading Dragon of Red Dawn from the Magic Tree House series! Then, students will get to pick a country they want to research. We will round out the month by planning, drafting, and publishing informational writing pieces on our selected countries.

Grade 4: Fourth graders will be finishing our unit on Colonial America and will begin to investigate and learn about the American Revolution. Students will learn about different perspectives of the time period. For math students are finishing up the geometry unit and will begin the unit study of fractions. Students will learn to decompose, compare, add and subtract fractions. In science class, students have begun a unit on Earth Processes and will explore rocks and fossils. Please continue to practice multiplication and division facts and also read each night!

Grade 5: In math, we are continuing our work with fractions focusing on Module 4: Multiplication and Division of Fractions and Decimal Fractions. In ELA, we are wrapping up our work with Who Was? biographies related to Black History Month. Students are working on a final project about their biography subject to share with classmates! We will be moving on to some review and practie of short response strategies to prepare for upcoming state testing. In writing, we are continuing our work with opinion writing. Students are working on persuasive leads to begin their writing and pulling evidence from a text to support their opinion. We recently wrapped up our social studes unit on complex societies-students enjoyed learning about the Incas, Mayas, and Aztecs and what makes these societies complex!

## DATA CORNER

iReady sets yearly growth targets for our students. After the end diagnostic test, data show:

- $63 \%$ of students have already met their Reading Growth target!
- $38 \%$ have already met their Math Growth target!

We are so incredibly proud of our students and look forward to seeing the progress they'll make during the 2 nd half of the year!!
