As the official first day of winter draws near, I would like to review some important information with you regarding our procedures for snow days and other emergency scenarios. Please be aware that our school calendar this year includes 4 additional days (*beyond the NYS requirements*), which could be used for snow days or other weather emergencies if necessary. In the event that we need more than 4 days for snow or other weather emergencies, the district will transition to remote learning days. If we need to engage in remote learning, you will receive information from us about how that will work for our students.
