## **PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION**

**We are pleased to announce that on Monday, March 11th, 2024, the Northmont Preschool will begin new student registration for the 2024-2025 school year for typically developing children who are residents of the Northmont City Schools District. Priority placements will be given to children who are 4 years old on or before August 1st. If spots remain, three year old students will be accepted. All children must be toilet trained, have well-developed language skills, and acceptable social skills to enroll as a typical peer role model in the preschool for the 2024-2025 school year. Letters will be mailed by April 3rd to notify you of acceptance to the program or placement on the waiting list. Children who are five years old on or before August 1st are eligible to enroll in kindergarten.**



## **KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION**

Do you have a child who will be 5 by August 1st? If so, they are eligible for kindergarten next year. Kindergarten Registration for the 2024-25 school year will begin on Monday, April 1st. Please visit the Northmont Schools website and click the Kindergarten Enrollment tab.


