Principal's Message

Our teachers and students have done a lot of work over the past two school years around literacy. We have been implementing cross-content literacy strategies in all of our subject areas, and I am really proud of the way our teachers have implemented this important work. I am also very proud of the growth that our students have shown over the past two years, as measured by both the PSAT/SAT and the CommonLit assessment. We saw substantial growth across the school, and also in all grade levels and specific student groups. The CommonLit assessment is being given three times during the 23-24 school year: Beginning of Year (Fall), Middle of Year (Winter), and End of Year (Spring). I highly encourage parents to view the reports for their student, and including instructions below. Please note that the most important thing that we focus on is growth, and I ask that you do the same.

Regional Science Fair








Fun stuff going on in the Engineering wing!
