Getting to know your Centaurus Team
Science Teacher- Eric Mattys



I grew up in Colorado Springs and didn't really fit into the conservative culture of the area. My parents were hippies who became hardworking when they had kids. I studied Biology with a minor in English on an academic scholarship at Whittier College (home of the fighting Poets) in Southern California. I started recording music in the study rooms at the school's library when I wasn't tutoring other students or trying to learn how to ride waves. I saved money to buy recording equipment while taking all the Pre-Med courses. After graduating I almost went to chiropractic school before moving back to Colorado Springs and installing home theater systems, and then working as a sales representative for a biotechnology company. In 2006 I released an album called, "You Don't Have to Close Your Eyes" which had a lot to do with leaving LA. Sales work and feeling trapped in Colorado Springs was not a good fit for me at that point in my life. I saved up money, quit and moved to Boulder to write a novel and play music-finishing a draft of my first novel and releasing another music album. I started grad school in science education at CU the next fall. Major differences in school became apparent to me during grad school. In the mornings I had a practicum class at Peak to Peak School where advanced Biology students built models of DNAm and also worked at Justice High School. From these two environments the common thread was the importance of building trust with students. Shortly after I finished my Masters in Education, I started working at Centaurus. In 2016 I met my wife, Ash and her son Jett. She helped me edit my first novel, The Potential of Zeroes, which I published in 2018. In 2019 we got married in our backyard. In 2020 Ridge was born. The day he was born was the first day we started teaching class remotely because of COVID. I taught class from the hospital room. In 2022, I released an album of music titled "Then... Love." In the summer of 2022 I worked with the Department of Statistical Genetics at UC Denver as part of the Rocky Mountain Summer Research Educator Experience. It has shifted my teaching toward helping students find ways to do their own research. This last fall, Ash started teaching Language Arts at Fairview High School. We both feel so lucky to be a part of our learning communities! I'm working on a second novel now.
