School Board Meeting Highlights
March 4, 2024
Regular Meeting**

At the March 4, 2024 Regular Meeting of the School Board, the following items were presented and discussed:

1. **Student Recognition.** The School Board recognized students who have represented the district in various activities, including: the Cheer Team, which competed at both state and national levels, and a member of the Gymnastics Team who competed at the State Meet. Additionally, students who participate in honored state-level orchestra, band and choir events were recognized.

2. **American Indian Parent Advisory Committee Resolution of Concurrence or Nonconcurrence.** A representative of the committee presented information about the American Indian Parent Advisory Committee Resolution of Concurrence or Nonconcurrence.
3. **Naming of White Bear Lake Area High School Gymnasium.** Tim Wald, Assistant Superintendent for Finance and Operations, presented a recommendation on the name of the White Bear Lake Area High School gymnasium.

4. **First Reading of School Board Policies.** The School Board heard first readings of the following policies, as recommended by the Policy Committee and Cabinet:

 - c. 901, Community Education;
 - d. 903, Visitors to School District Property and Facilities;
 - e. 905, Advertising; and
 - f. 906, Community Notification of Predatory Offenders.

At the March 4, 2024 Regular Meeting of the School Board, the following items were acted upon:

1. **Action on Naming of White Bear Lake Area High School Gymnasium.** The School Board approved “Galvin Court” as the name of the White Bear Lake Area High School gymnasium as recommended.

2. **Action on Acceptance of Glasrud Grants.** The School Board accepted the resolution for 7 Glasrud Grants from the White Bear Lake Area Educational Foundation.

3. **Action on Bids for Vadnais Heights Elementary Partial Roof Replacement.** The School Board accepted the overall bid for the Vadnais Heights Elementary Partial Roof Replacement Package as presented, to BL Dalsin Roofing in the amount of \$633,317.00.
4. **Action on Bids for Sunrise Park Middle School Renovation Technology Package.** The School Board accepted the overall bid for the Sunrise Park Middle School Renovation Technology Package as presented, to Advanced Systems Integration (ASI) in the amount of \$618,543.75.
5. **Action on School Board Policies.** The School Board acted upon the following policies, as recommended by the Policy Committee and Cabinet:
 - a. 408, Subpoena of a School District Employee;
 - b. 409, Employee Publications, Instructional Materials, Inventions and Creations;
 - c. 410, Family and Medical Leave Act and District Leaves of Absence Policy;
 - d. 430, Employee/Visitor ID Badge; and
 - e. 904, Distribution of Materials on School District Property by Nonschool Persons.
