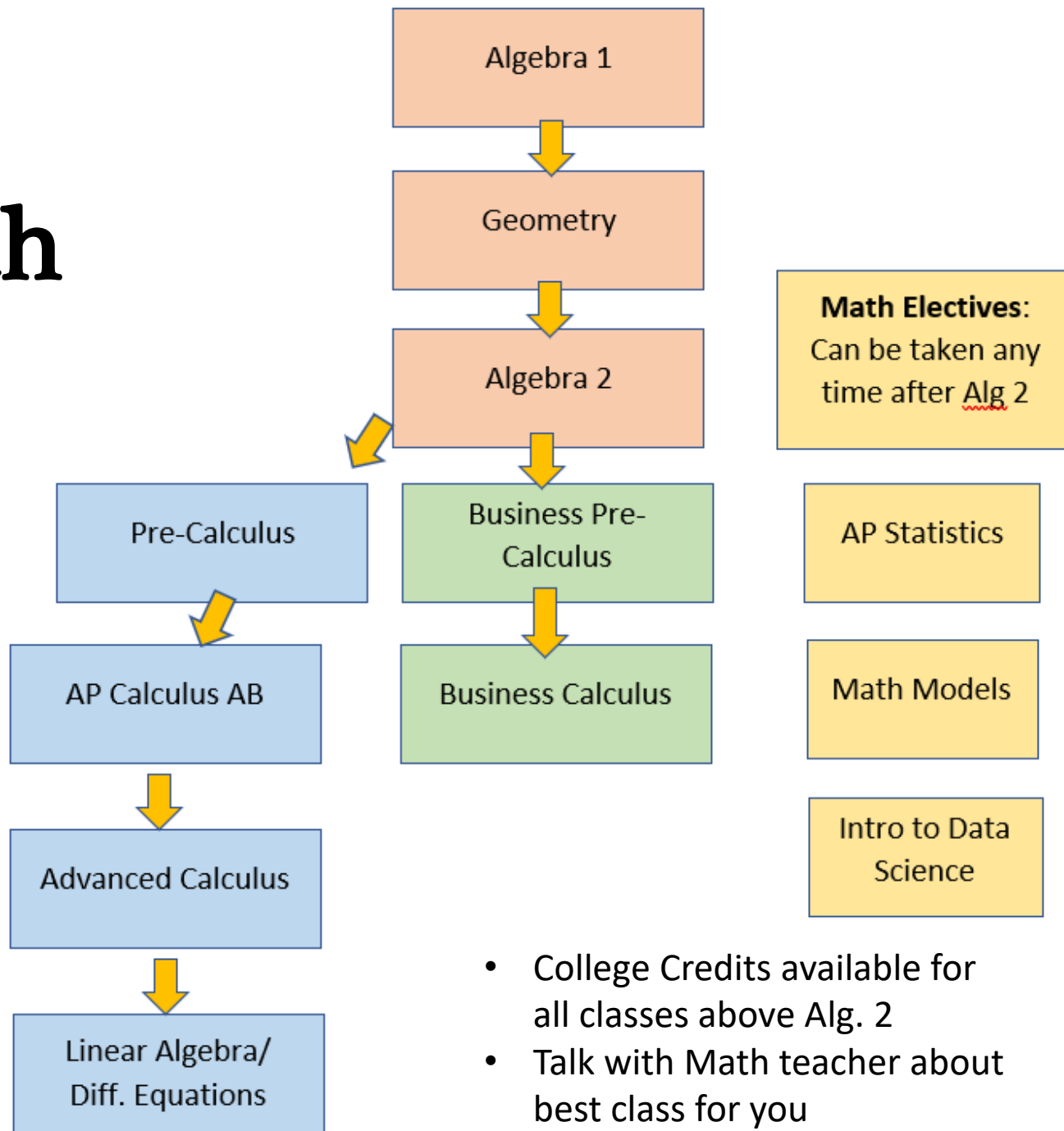

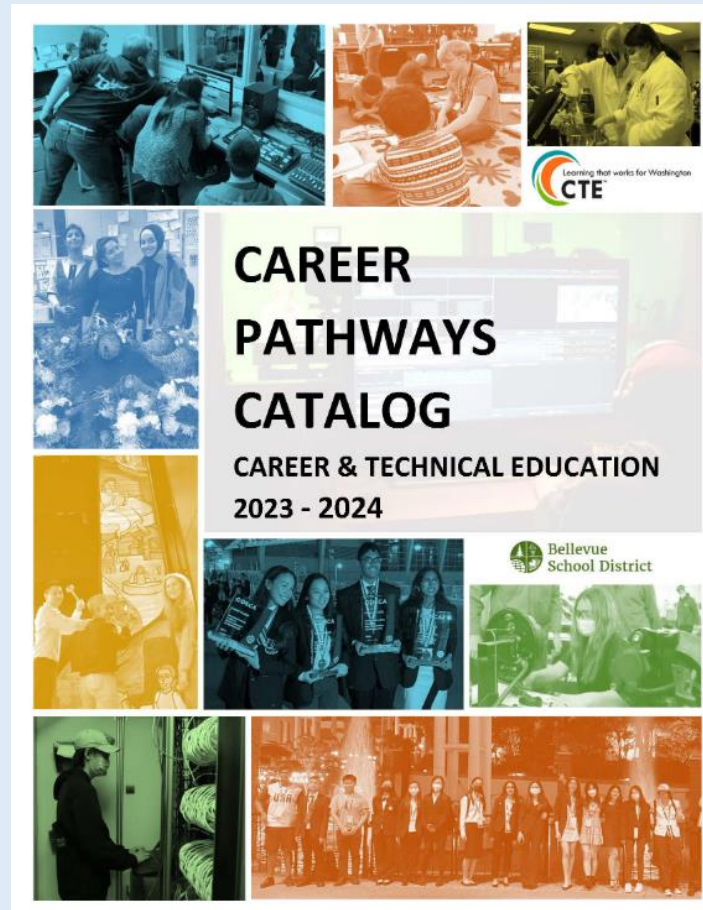

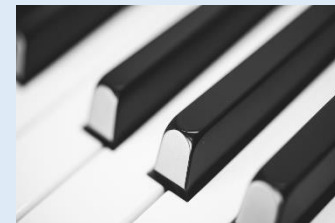

- Complete directions on NHS website
- Parents and students should discuss courses
- Counselors will be able to correct selections when meeting with students
- If you make a mistake, no need to panic, counselors will fix problems 😊

REMINDERS!

Choose carefully! You are committing to take the courses you choose

Alternates are considered requests when your first selection is not available

If **retaking a failed class**, consult with your Counselor for options

Aim for balance & choose what is ***best for you*** – resist “peer pressure”

Consult with current teachers about which courses to take (i.e. AP, Math, Science, etc.)
