Additional Requirements:

- **Graduation Pathway**
 - ✓ 2 cr of CTE sequence in same path
 - ✓ ASVAB (score = 31)

 - Or, ELA & Math – (could combine):
 - ✓ Dual Credit ELA or Math classes (RS, CiHS, AP with C+)
 - ✓ **SBA ELA &/or Math – most use this option**
 - ✓ SAT/ACT scores
 - ✓ AP test scores

- **High school & Beyond Plan**
 - ✓ 7 tasks via Naviance

- **Community Service - 40 hours**

- **GPA - 2.0 GPA required**



- Students select level based on:

WORLD LANGUAGE

- Graduation Requirement: 2 Credits
- College Preference: 2 years of same language required; 3 to 4 years recommended.
- Personal Pathway Option
- Spanish Immersion: Honors Hispanic Studies
- Offerings at Newport: French, Spanish, Chinese, and Arabic
- World Language Competency Test
 - Earn up to 1 to 4 credits for World Language (Must be able to speak and read and listen)
 - Check specific college recommendations

HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Health—10th Grade Required Course

- Summer WANIC Health class is also an option. Student will receive letter grade on transcripts.

- Students can choose to take Health through Outside Learning Institution over the summer. However, incoming 10th grade students still must check the box for health on the registration form until course is completed.
- If students choose to take health over the summer, it will not be replaced with another class until the registrar has received the official transcript from the institution stating health was completed in the summer.

Physical Education

- Washington state requires all students to have at least 1.5 credits of Physical Education in order to graduate high school.
- 1 credit completed in 9th grade. The other .5 credit can be completed anytime between 10th and 12th grade.
- Sport for PE Credit can be earned for .5 of the PE credit. The student must be currently participating in the sport. The hours must be logged, with at least 80 hours of playing/practice time completed, as well as passing the written portion of the PE exam within the same school year.
