Beyond those four classes, students may pick to do AL HS Program Internship (2.0 credits) or up to 3.0 credits of ANYTHING – including World Language.

- IB Physics SL2/AP Physics 2
- IB Physics HL/AP Physics 2
- IB/AP Environmental Science
- IB Biology SL
- IB Biology HL/AP Biology
- IB Design Technology SL
- IB Chemistry SL2/AP Chemistry
- WANIC options that include science: Nursery & Greenhouse, Building Industry Technologies CorePlus Construction, Automotive Technology (BHS), Health Science Careers (Nursing) (SHS)

Make sure to plan your courses to meet Graduation Requirements that must be done sometime in high school:

- 1.0-2.0 Fine Arts
- 1.0 CTE
- 1.5 PE

- IB Chinese 3 ab initio (after Chinese 2)
- IB Chinese 4 SL (after Chinese 3)
- AP French Language & Culture (after IB testing)
- IB French Language & Lit SL2
- IB Spanish 3 ab initio (after Spanish 2)
- IB Spanish 4 SL (after Spanish 3)
- AP Spanish Language
- *NO World Language*
