

9<sup>™</sup> Grader who scored 4-5-6 in our placement test. (Intermediate-mid/high writing proficiency).




If the lang/lit is not running, I think students from immersion should follow the sequencing: AP-Spanish 5— Spanish 6 (gifted) or Spanish 4-AP-5-6 (for general education), that need to be discussed though. Students in the IB diploma can always choose another language (AB Initio) or do Self-Study in literature. In Spanish, we should give the option for student to test in Spanish B because they are acquisition learner (they usually come from immersion but are not native speaker not like Chinese and French).
