- Reside and attend school in one the following seven counties: (1) Sacramento, (2) SanJoaquin, (3) Solano, (4) Sutter, (5) Yolo, (6) Yuba; (7) Placer and
- Attend a four-year university/college, community college, or vocational school in the 2024-2025 academic year.

Additionally, this year the APSEA Foundation will also be awarding a scholarship to a student emphasizing diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) qualities. Applicants must demonstrate their commitment to DEI through community service in their community (does NOT have to be specially the AAPI community).
