EDUCATION FOUNDATION

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships have been established in order to enable members of M.R.P.S., who have the ability and promise, to secure a college education. Students who qualify may attend any accredited college or university of their choosing. Scholarships will be awarded each year to graduating high school seniors at the time of application, or to members who are presently pursuing a college degree.

ELIGIBILITY: students applying for scholarships must meet the following qualifications:

1. Candidates must be members of M.R.P.S. for at least three years and in good standing. If younger than eighteen (18), or a student dependent, then parents/legal guardian must be paid up members for at least three (3) years. **(yearly dues must be paid)**
2. Candidates must have maintained a minimum of a "B" average in their high school courses, verified by school transcripts.
3. Those members who have been out of high school for a period of time must demonstrate completion of a minimum of one semester of college credit (15 units), with a "B" average, verified by school administration.
4. Candidates must meet all requirements of admission set down by the college of their choosing.
5. No application will be accepted from an applicant who has previously been awarded a scholarship from this Foundation.

REQUIREMENTS:

It is the responsibility of the applicant to submit the following:

1. Completed application with cover letter. Letter to include reasons why M.R.P.S. should grant candidate a scholarship. Letter to be a maximum of 500 words.
2. Official high school transcript, including first semester in senior year.
3. At least two letters of recommendation. One must be from a certificated school employee and the other from any source except a relative.
4. It is the candidate's responsibility to submit as many supporting documents as they deem necessary to strengthen their application.
5. Application and supporting documents must be submitted to the scholarship committee on or before March 31, 2019.

BASIS OF SELECTION

The Scholarship Committee, after receiving the applications, will make recommendations to the Board of Directors of M.R.P.S., who will in turn award the scholarships. Scholarships will be awarded based on 100 points: grade point average 40 points; active involvement with M.R.P.S. 40 points; extra-curricular activities 10 points; Portuguese decent 10 points.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF AWARDS AND PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Recipients of scholarships will be notified as soon as possible. The scholarship will be awarded to the recipient upon proof of full time registration to a college or university.

MABEL MACHADO SERVICE SCHOLARSHIPS

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ELIGIBILITY: students applying for scholarships must meet the following qualifications:

2. Candidates must meet graduation requirements, verified by school transcripts.
3. Those members who have been out of high school for a period of time must demonstrate completion of a minimum of one semester of college credit (15 units), with passing grades, verified by school administration.
4. Candidates must meet all requirements of admission set down by the college of their choosing.
5. No application will be accepted from an applicant who has previously been awarded a scholarship from this Foundation.

REQUIREMENTS:

It is the responsibility of the applicant to submit the following:

1. Completed application with cover letter. Letter to include reasons why M.R.P.S. should grant candidate a scholarship. Letter to be a maximum of 500 words.
2. Official high school transcript, including first semester in senior year.
3. At least two letters of recommendation. One must be from a certificated school employee and the other from any source except a relative.
4. It is the candidate's responsibility to submit as many supporting documents as they deem necessary to strengthen their application.
5. Application and supporting documents must be submitted to the scholarship committee on or before March 31, 2024.

Scholarships will be awarded based on 100 points: grade point average 10 points; active involvement with M.R.P.S. 70 points; extra-curricular activities 10 points; Portuguese decent 10 points.

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
