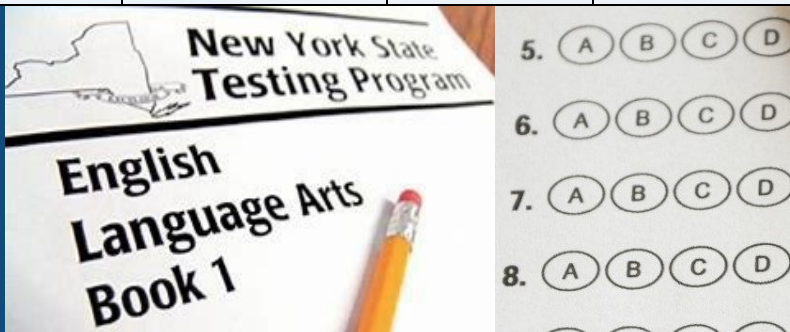

### Taking Regents (Math and Science)

If your district is not planning to administer the Grade 6, 7, or 8 NYS Math or Grade 8 NYS Science assessment to students taking the Algebra I, Earth Science, or Living Environment Regents, the “Taking Regents” reason Not Tested Code should be set for the applicable students in Nextera Admin for CBT or the “Taking Regents” Reason Not Tested Code should be bubbled on the applicable students’ answer sheets for PBT.

### NYSITELL

- The NYSITELL is used for initially identifying English Language Learners (ELL students).
- Administered on answer sheets provided by EduTech. PDFs to print additional answer sheets are available at: <https://tscorftp.edutech.org>
- After administration, the completed answer sheet must be scanned and loaded to ASAP to get the student’s performance level on an ASAP report.
- This process began in 2018.

### NYSESLAT

Students must have the 0231 :: ELL Eligible record & applicable ELL Program Code record in Level 0 by **3/1/24** to receive a pre-printed NYSESLAT answer sheet.

Students whose ELL status ended in 2023 should not have any ELL records reported in Level 0 for 2024.

### Which students will receive pre-printed June Regents Answer Sheets?

The **Exam Roster** report in ASAP shows the students linked to each course mapped to a state Regents course code and will be available March 25.

Login to ASAP *using Level 0 credentials*  
Select Regents > Click **Reports** >  
Choose **Exam Roster**

Answer sheets will be provided for the students included on each Regents Exam Roster report. EduTech Test Scoring will be collecting course #/course names and Regents exam for students in official AP or IB courses as well as students who will be re-taking a Regents exam(s) in June 2024.
