### **School Responsibilities**

Triton Regional High School will:

1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the challenging State academic standards as follows: Providing faculty with current and research based professional development, utilizing Title 1 funding to create academic resources and outreaches for our students and update course curriculum regularly to stay abreast on state testing expectations.
