- Provide general supervision of students at all times in the building (including lunch and recess)

- Monitors and updates curriculum maps and maintain curriculum standards in collaboration with the math department

- Works with students during study halls and office hours
- Demonstrates knowledge of students and how they learn, and implements new teaching models to match student needs
- Participates in peer review through observation and coaching following the VMS professional growth plan

- Works with MS Director, Director of Student Support Services to support the policies and implementation of academic probation and restriction for students
- Works to ensure that there is a fair amount of graded opportunities that exist for every class and that there is consistent communication for every class
- Advocate for and ensure that diversity, inclusion, and social justice permeates the school's programs and drives its culture.
