Science and Engineering Fair Recognition Winners

It brings me immense joy to announce that numerous members of our Science Fair Team have been chosen to receive one or more accolades for their exceptional project work! This accomplishment showcases the remarkable talent within our team, and I couldn't be prouder. A total of 25 Fairview students presented their projects at the BVSD Corden Pharma Regional

Science and Engineering Fair. 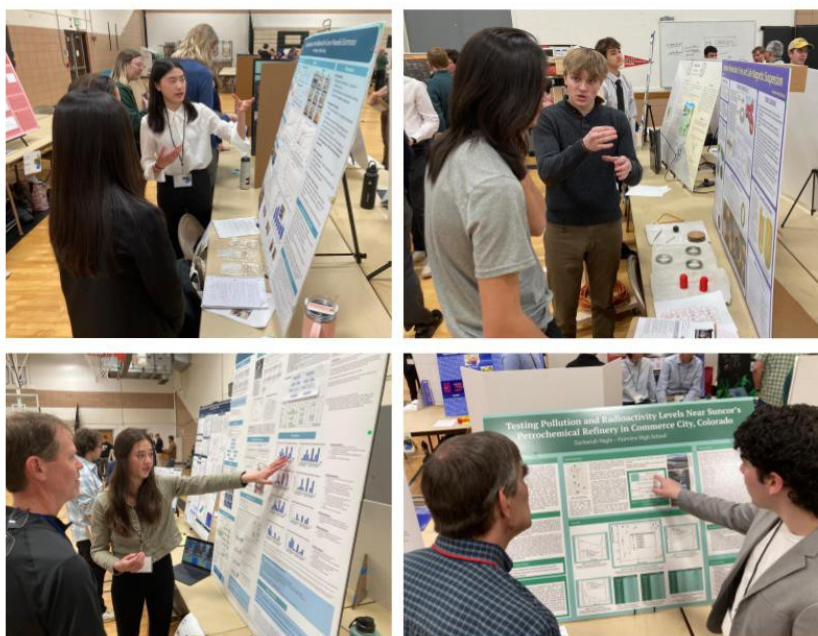

Fairview Speech & Debate celebrates Rebel Invite 1st & 2nd place finishes

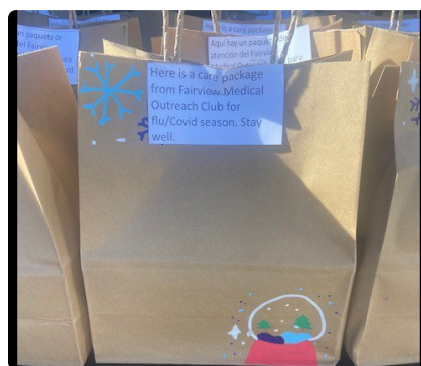

ASCENT is a program through which you can get one free year of tuition, books and fees at UNC, Metro, or FRCC. To participate, students must complete at least 9 college credits by May of senior year. AP scores (for tests taken during junior year) can count, as do CLEP scores. CLEP tests are 2 hour tests on a variety of subjects, and I can sign you up for these at no cost to you. Interested 9th, 10th and 11th graders – start planning now by building concurrent enrollment, dual enrollment, and District Select classes into your schedule. I can help you with this.
