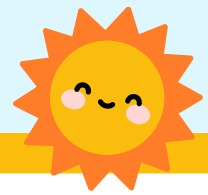

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PROGRAM TYPES

MULTIPLE-DAY CAMPS

We offer camps that are three to four days long. Camps are planned based on an age group and a themed topic! For camps with our Roseville Area Schools Community Education instructors, you can register for a full day option with lunch included, or just the morning or afternoon camp.
