STEAM with Littlebits: Grades 4-5 Room 19

In this course, we help explore the creativity of your kids and turn their ideas into reality with the littleBits STEAM kit! LittleBits is an easy, flexible, and accessible way to learn electronics, coding fundamentals, and engineering design principles. With these littleBits cross-curricular lessons, your kids will develop important STEAM skills while having fun. Kids will snap together the easy-to-use building blocks, fully utilize the capabilities of littleBits, code the codeBit through blocks, and make inventions with their kit.

Disaster Island: Grades 1-5

Inspired by the bestselling "I Survived" book series, Disaster Island© will take your STEAM Team on a thrilling adventure through some of the most famous disasters in history! From the eruption of Mount Vesuvius to the sinking of the Titanic to the Great San Francisco earthquake, you and your STEAM teammates will work together to overcome epic challenges using only the materials in your treasure chest and the power of your imagination!

Tennis/Pickleball: Grades 1-5

Students will learn to play tennis on portable nets set up on blacktops and low compression tennis balls. Fun games and activities are used to improve tennis-related skills of our students that will not only carry over to tennis but other sports as well.

Movin' and Groovin': Grades K-5

Discover renewable and non-renewable resources for power generation, and build your own optical fiber model as we talk about telecommunications!

Futsal Soccer is a fun, fast-paced five per side soccer game played indoors and outdoors within the lines of a basketball court or lined field (no walls) using a small, size three ball with low-bounce. Play fun, educational games that focus on increasing balance, coordination and fundamental futsal skills.
