# ~ KINDERGARTEN~

Kindergarten is busy at work learning how to read. We are working on reading decodable words (consonant-vowel-consonant). We are also learning to read sight words that we call "heart words" because we need to know them by heart.

# Rain Cloud in a Jar

#### Materials:

- Mason jar or glass cup
- Water
- White shaving cream
- Food coloring

#### Procedure:

- 1. Fill cup or mason jar 3/4 full with water
- 2. Add a shaving cream cloud on top of the water
- 3. Place drops of food coloring on top of the cloud
- 4. Wait to see what happens with the drops add more if needed
- What happens to the drops?
- How many drops did it take to rain? What caused it to rain?
