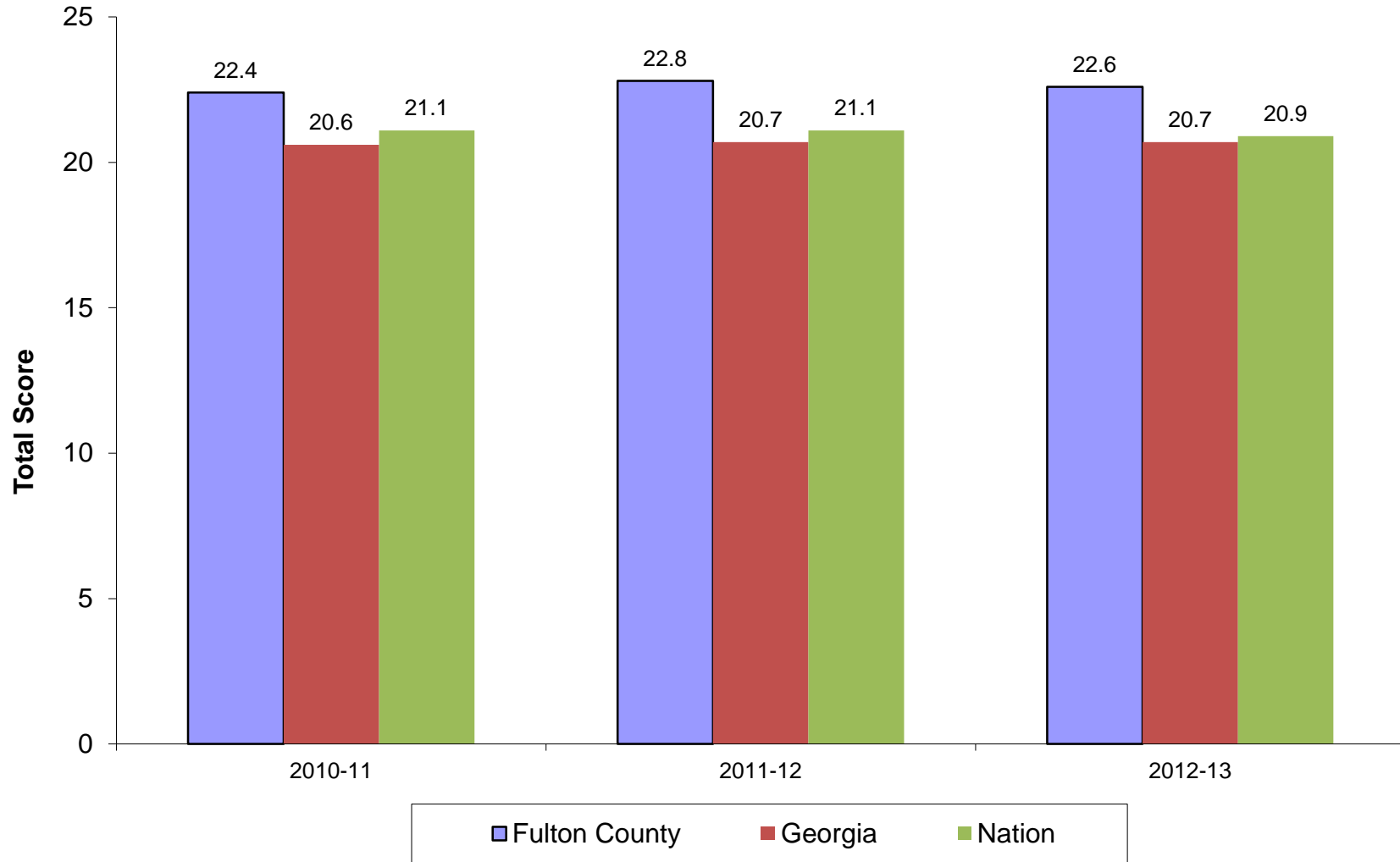

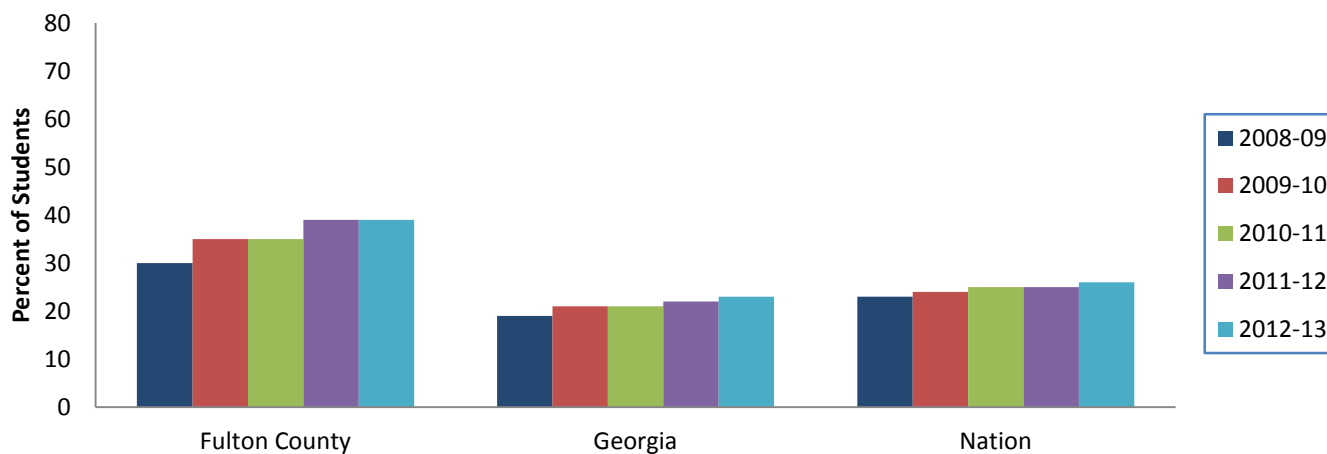

Fulton County Three Year Comparison Composite ACT Scores

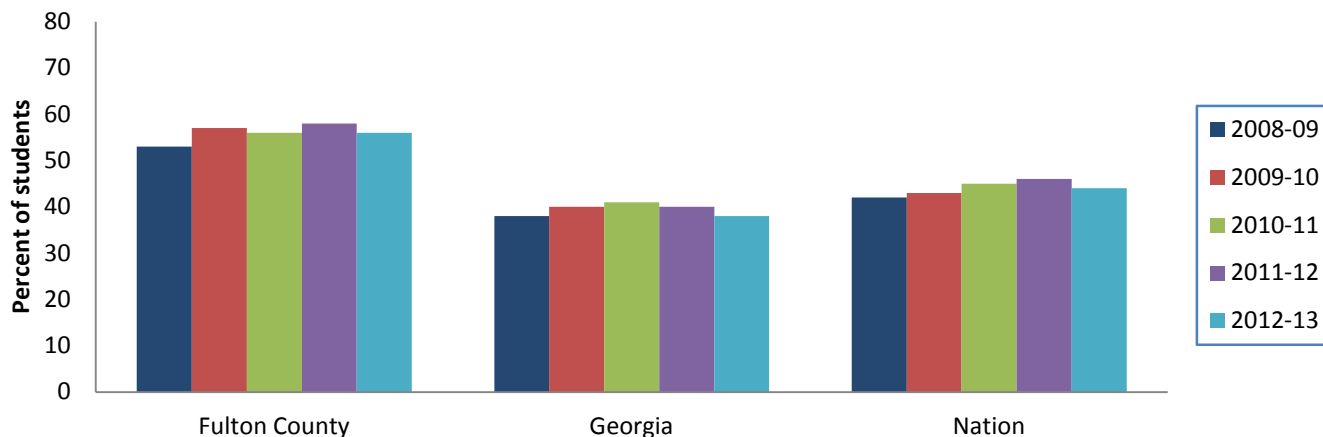


Fulton County Schools ACT College Readiness Benchmarks

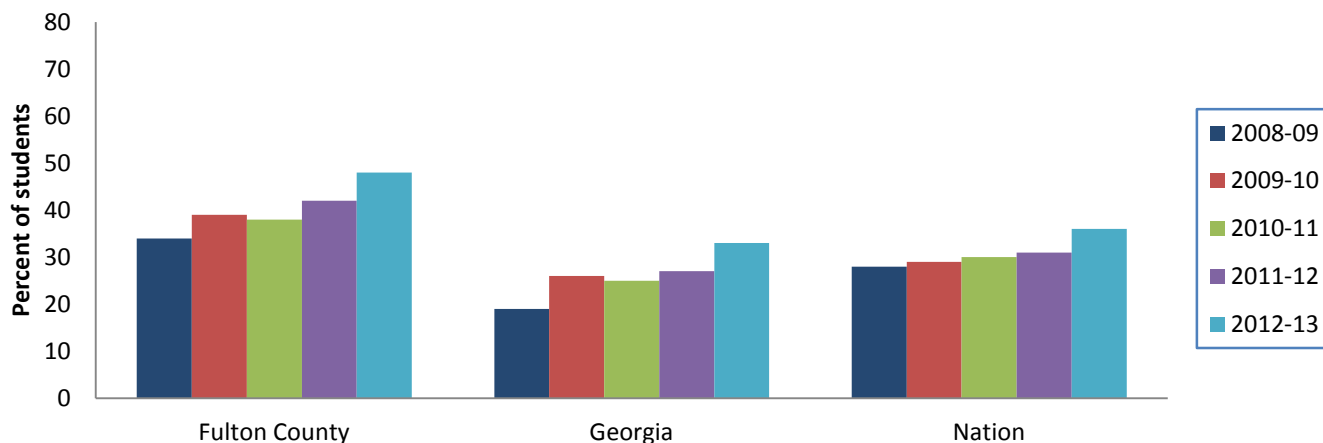
Percent Meeting All Four Benchmarks



Percent Meeting Mathematics Benchmark

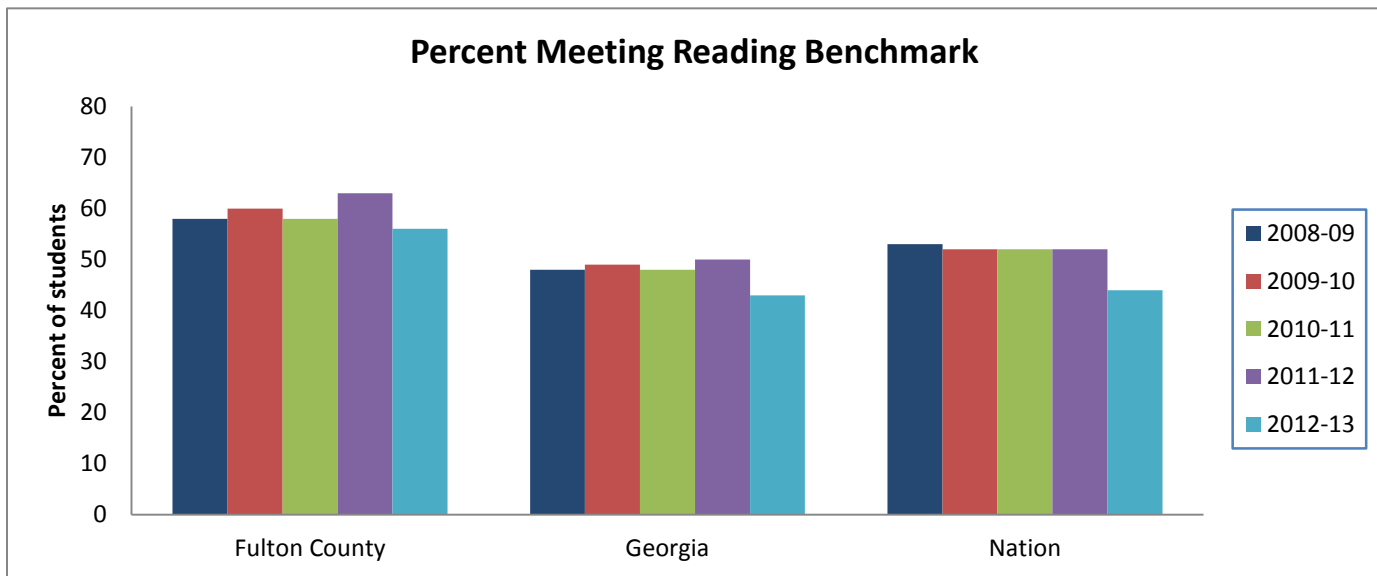
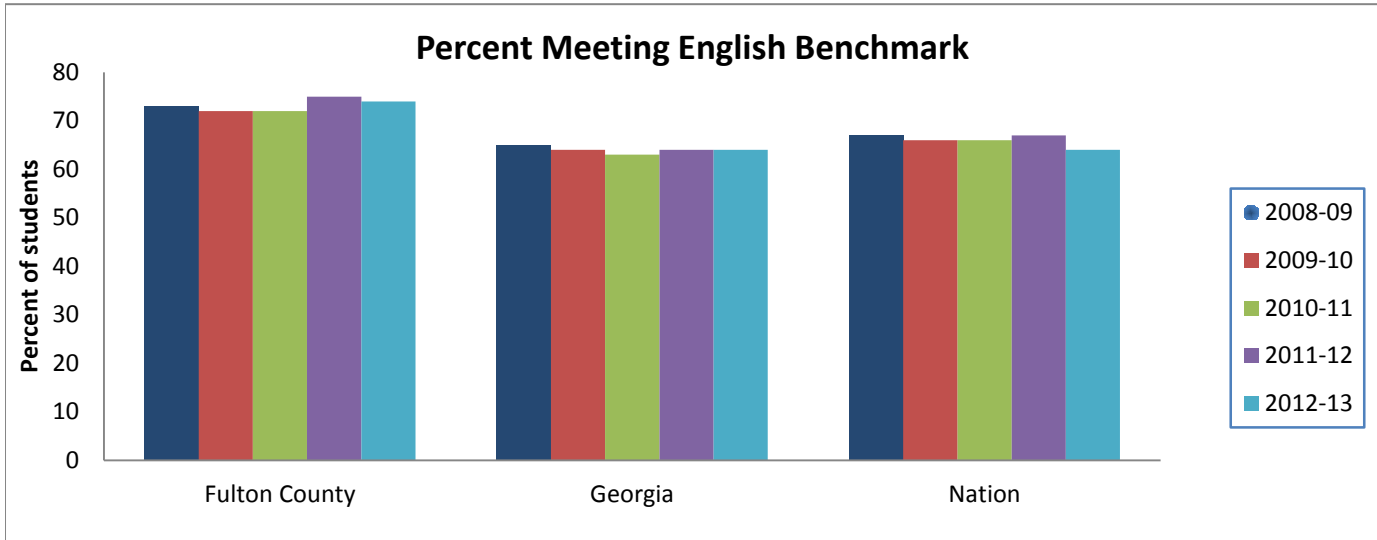


Percent Meeting Science Benchmark

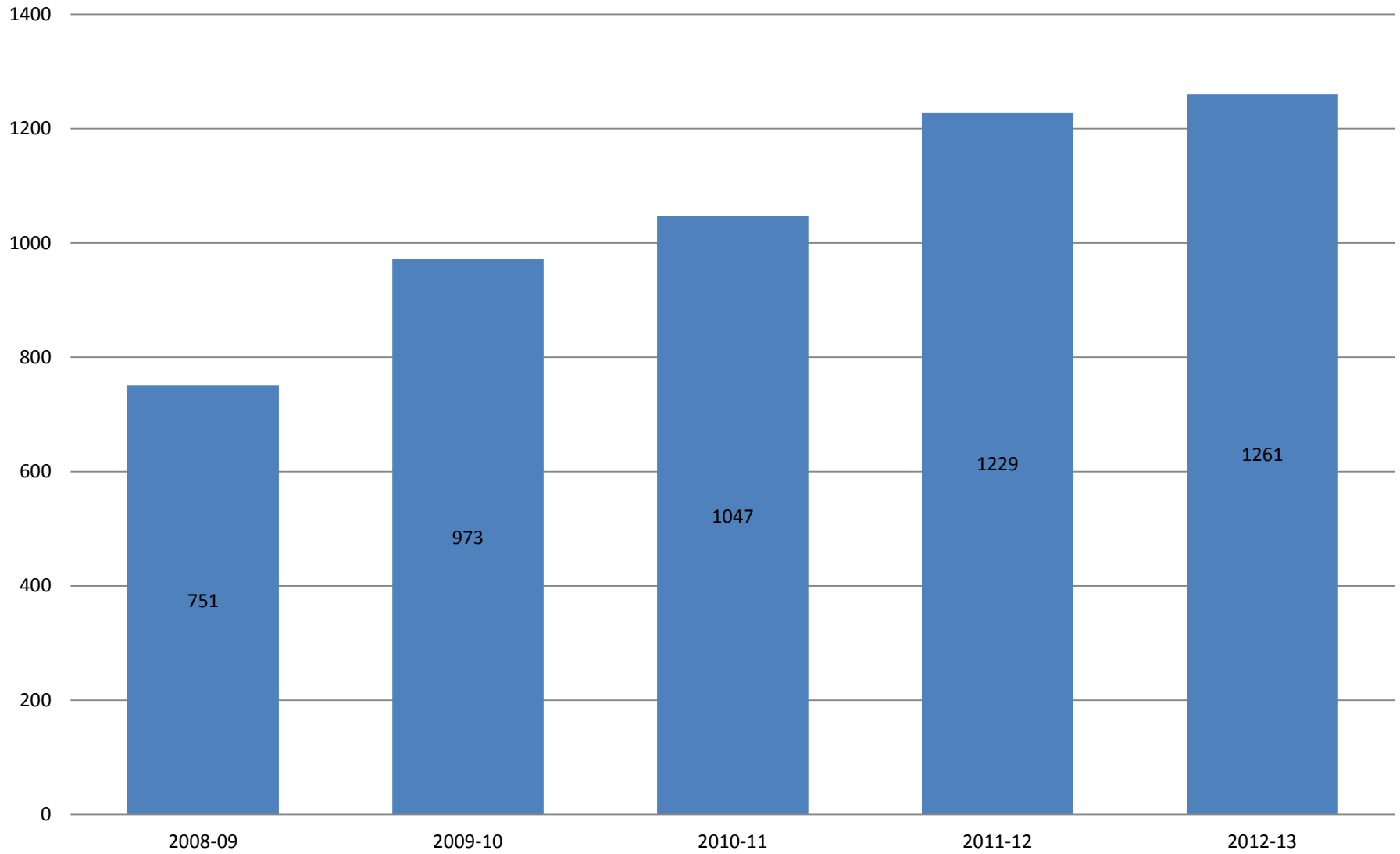
Fulton County Schools ACT College Readiness Benchmarks
