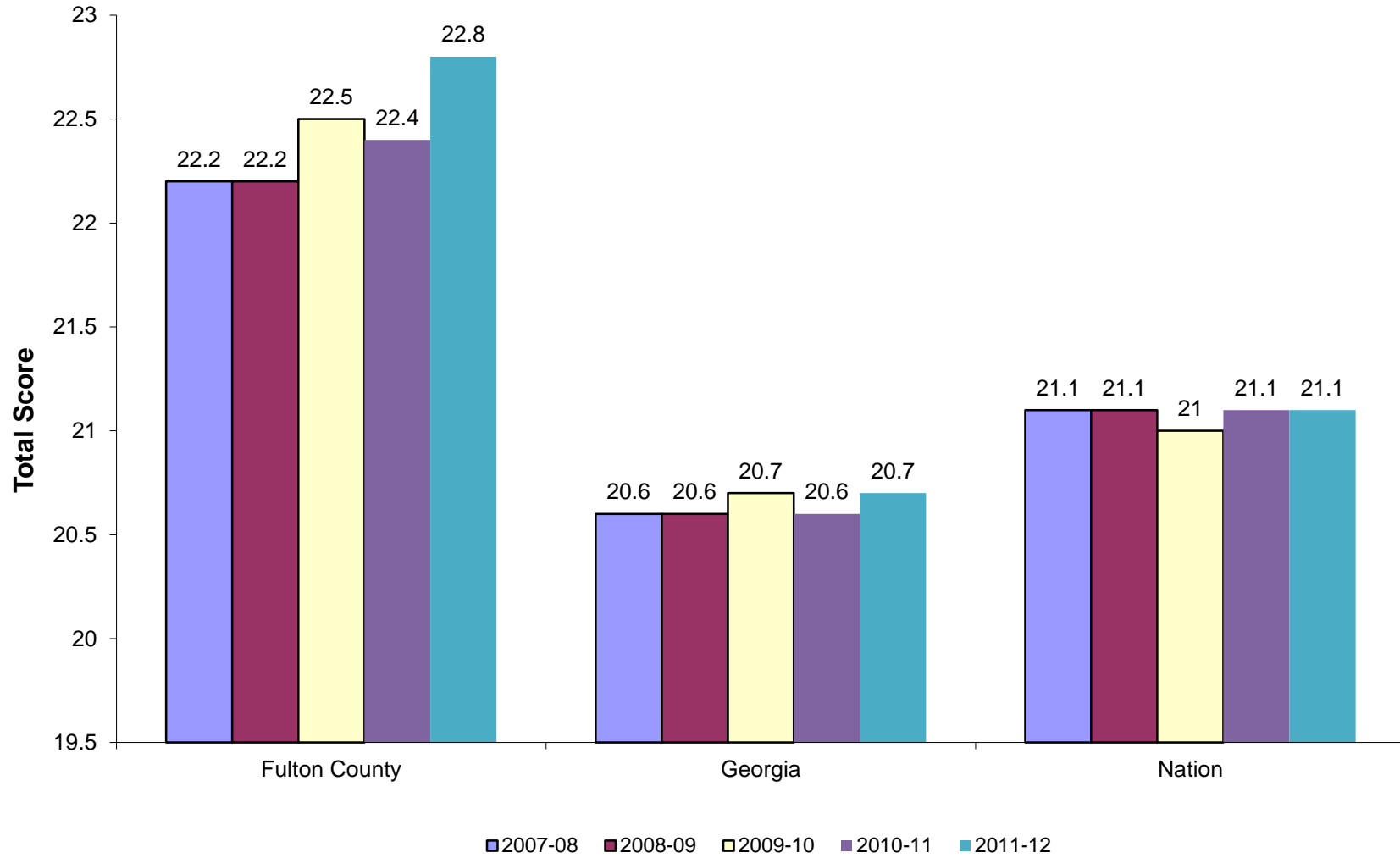

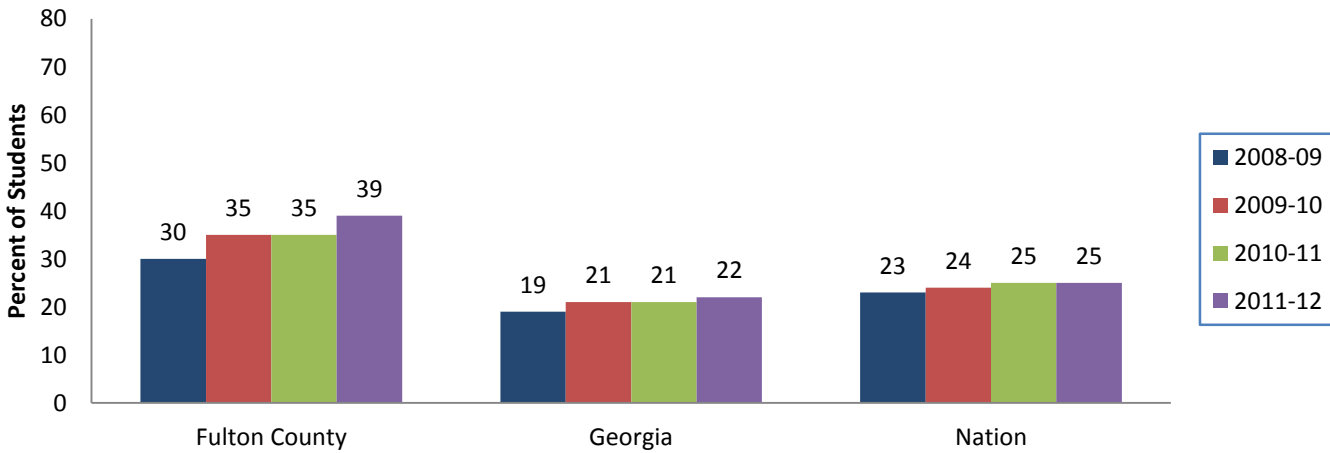

Five Year Trend for Composite ACT Scores

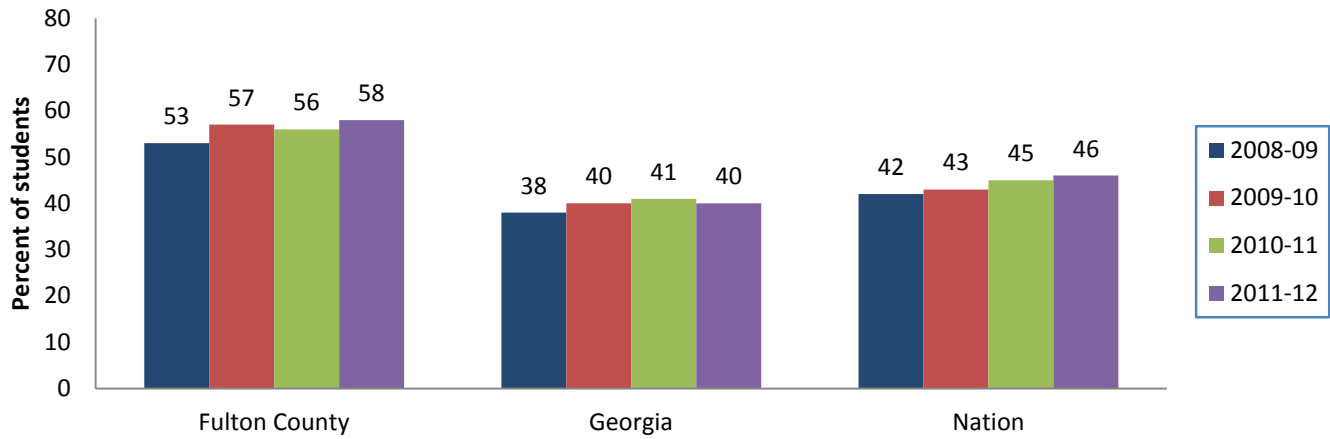

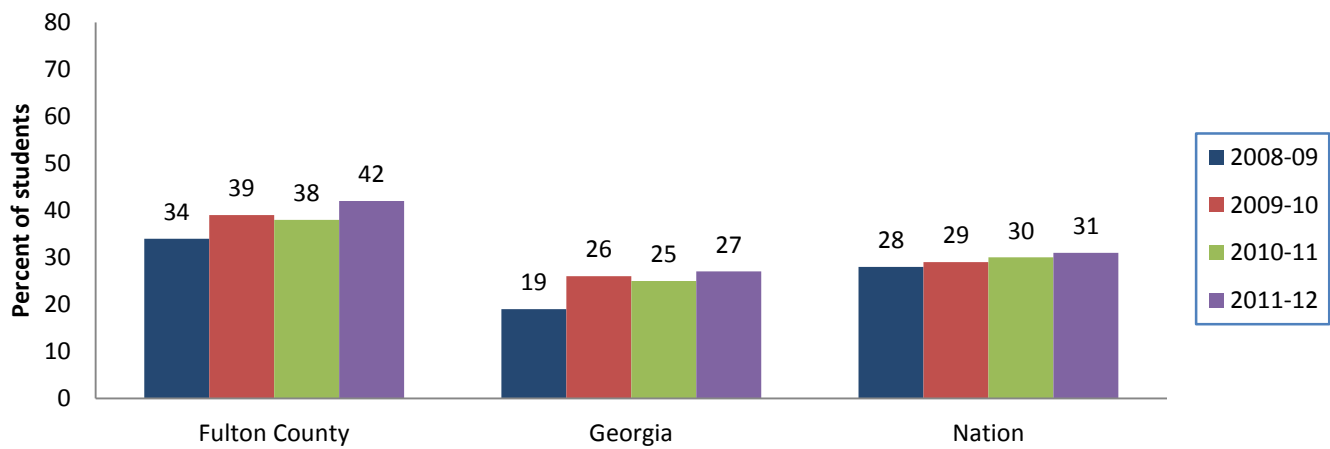
Percent Meeting All Four Benchmarks



Percent Meeting Mathematics Benchmark

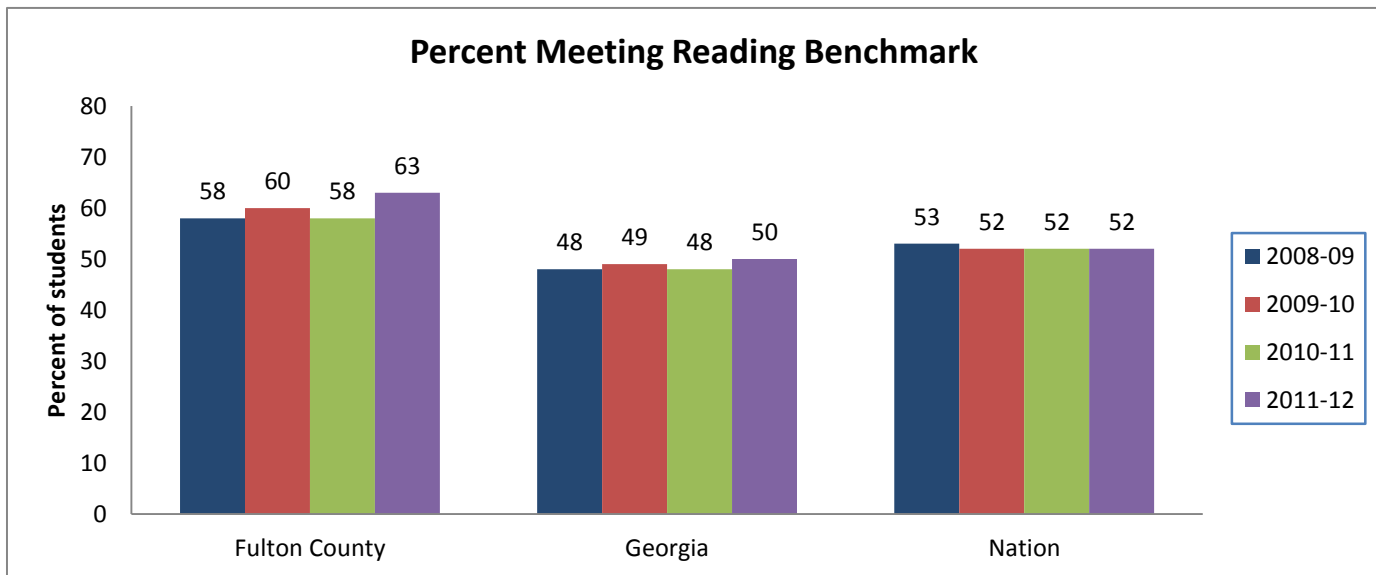
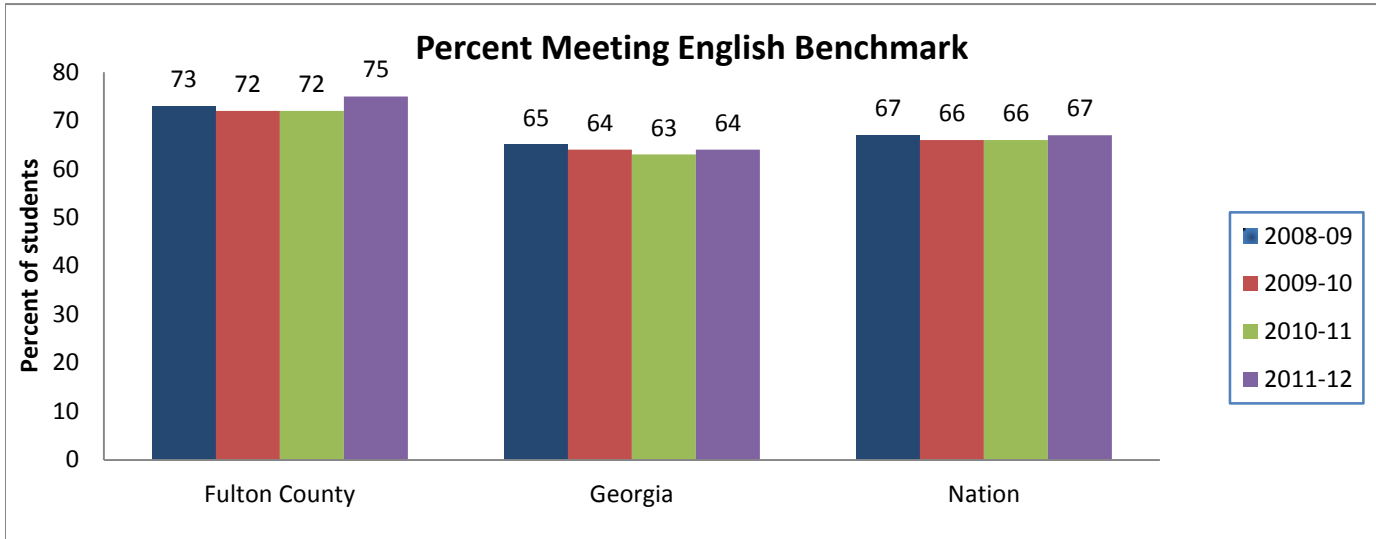


Percent Meeting Science Benchmark
