Critical actions: What major actions will we complete and by when?

- Create/publicize/maintain behavior expectations for students, staff, and stakeholders starting August 2018
- Host diversity training for staff during 2018-2019 school year
- Create and maintain a student mentorship program for struggling students starting March 2018

Evidence of progress: How will we know that the initiative is working?

- Students, staff, and stakeholders will meet behavior expectations resulting in fewer behavior related meetings with administrators
- Staff will report feeling more equip to support our diverse student population on survey conducted at end of diversity training



Outcomes: What will success look like for our school?

Increase the percentage of stakeholders who would recommend working at or attending Autrey Mill MS to a family member or friend

- Create and maintain a transition website to house information about grade level transitions by May 2018
- Maintain regular communication with parents through email newsletters, Google Classroom, etc. throughout each school year
- Maintain regular communication with students and stakeholders inside the school building by obtaining and utilizing video monitors in the front rotunda and cafeteria

- Students will know where to locate school-related information
- Stakeholders will feel informed about school events and expectations



Critical actions: What major actions will we complete and by when?

- Invite/encourage stakeholders to participate in student mentoring throughout school year
- Create/maintain a list of students who could benefit from mentorship throughout school year
- Create mentorship guidelines and suggested activities for mentors by March 2018
- Create student permission form by March 2018

Evidence of progress: How will we know that the initiative is working?

- Number of stakeholders volunteering as student mentors will increase
- Number of students being mentored by stakeholders will increase



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Increase meaningful partnerships that support the school's plan and initiatives

- Invite/encourage community volunteerism throughout school year
- Continue Reach 1-1 Tutoring program with Johns Creek High School from late September through late March of each school year
- Create/maintain a teacher shadowing program to start September of 2018

- Number of stakeholders volunteering at school events will increase
- Number of students participating in Reach 1-1 Tutoring program will increase
- Teacher shadowing program will be established
