



The Call of the Wild

ABOUT THE AUTHOR

A fearless adventurer, Jack London (1876–1916) grew up in Oakland, California. His family was poor, so when he was a child he delivered newspapers, worked on an ice wagon, and set up pins at a bowling alley. After London left school in eighth grade, he worked at a cannery. While a teenager, London joined the crew of a seal-hunting boat. He sailed to Hawaii, Siberia, and Japan. When he returned home, he worked in a power plant.

In 1897, London joined the gold rush in the Yukon Territory of Canada. This is the setting for *The*

Call of the Wild, which was published in 1903. After returning to California in 1898, London decided to earn a living as a writer. He published more than twenty novels, as well as plays, essays, and stories.

BACKGROUND

In The Call of the Wild, Jack London vividly captures his firsthand experiences in the Yukon Territory. In 1896, gold was discovered in the Klondike region of the Yukon. Soon, thousands of rospectors streamed into this arctic wilderness, hoping to strike it rich.

London arrived in the Yukon in 1897. He camped in freezing cabins and walked for miles carrying

heavy packs filled with supplies. He met colorful figures, including grizzled miners, native Alaskans, nd a dog named Jack. Jack became the model for Buck in The Call of the Wild. Although he did no
