- ❑ Recommended for parents once they are registered in a Fulton County School
- ❑ To sign up, use school code is 87428
- ❑ Features Include:
 - Seeing the live location of your child's bus
 - You can see if the bus is running late and how far away the bus is
 - Set up personalized notifications
 - App available to download for free on iOS & Android
 - Multilingual
- ❑ Troubleshoot:
 - Try to reset your password by going to the website
 - Follow the instructions sent to your email address
 - Bus stop information will not be available on Saturday and Sunday

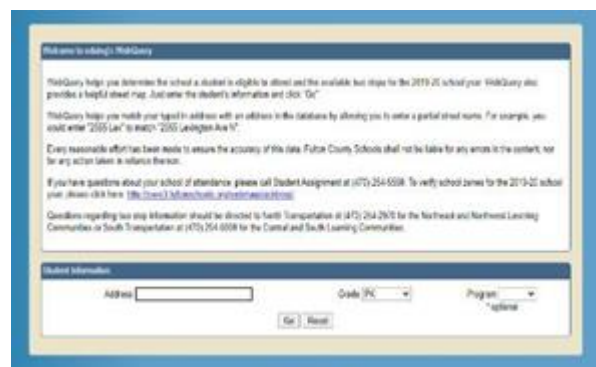


Webquery

Use Webquery to find your nearest bus stop – this may not be the actual stop for your child. Use this tool before your child is registered in a Fulton County School.

How to use it?

- ❑ www.fultonschools.org
- ❑ Select Transportation
- ❑ Select Bus Stop Information
- ❑ Put in your address
- ❑ Select your student's grade level
- ❑ Select go

School Bus Rules

Students:

- Use the handrail
- Sit bottom to bottom & back to back
- Place backpack in your lap
- Don't go into your backpack
- Wear your seatbelt
- Use inside voices
- Keep hands & feet to yourself
- No eating or drinking on the bus (Only Water)
- Be Respectful

Parents:

- Make sure to be at the bus stop 5 minutes early
- Help teach your students to wait 12 feet off the roadway
- Do NOT chase the bus if you missed it
- Do NOT go to another bus stop if your student misses the bus

Q. What do you grab when getting on the school bus?

A. The handrail

Q. What does it mean when the bus driver honks the horn for a long time?

A. Danger look out

Q. What are you supposed to do if you drop something outside the bus?

A. Wave your hands above your head to get your bus drivers attention

Q. What are the crossing signs in the morning?

A. The stop sign & sweep sign (show them with your hand) Make sure to tell your student to watch the bus driver and look before crossing the street and to look for any vehicles

Q. What are the crossing signs for the afternoon?

A. The stop sign at the end of the crossing gate. Then sweep in front of the bus. The stop sign for the other side of the bus. Then sweep for the student to finish crossing the street. Make sure that you tell your student that they need to pay attention to the bus driver

Q. What do you need to do when you get on the school bus?

A. Sit down, buckle up (If your bus is equipped), and put your backpack in your lap
