What is the FCS Technology Competition?

The Fulton County Schools Technology Competition is regional competition for the Georgia Student Technology Competition. GaSTC is a statewide technology competition where students in grades 3-12 compete in a variety of technology categories with the main goal of challenging students to become leaders in a digital age.

What do I need to do if I am interested in participating?

① Who can compete?

All **3rd -12th grade** Fulton County students are invited to enter a student-created technology project that aligns with one of the 14 GaSTC categories.

② How does it work?

Students may only enter **ONE** project into the competition that aligns to one of the 14 GaSTC categories.

Students may work individually or with one partner.

Projects are to be designed and created by students.

If a student is interested in participating, they must submit a school registration form and a copyright verification form to their school liaison before the school registration deadline. The school deadline is up to individual schools as ALL district registration forms are due by November 11th.

③ What is the timeline?

November 11th - Deadline for school liaisons to register eligible students

December 10th: In-Person Competition at Riverwood High School
