WHAT IS SAFARI MONTAGE?

SAFARI Montage is a digital repository of instructional videos that all students can access. Teachers may provide a direct link to a video for students to access or students may be asked to login and search for a video or other resource.

LOGGING INTO SAFARI MONTAGE FROM A RESOURCE LINK

If students click on a link to a SAFARI Montage resource, they will be brought to the SAFARI Montage login screen.

Username: Fulton student ID#

Password: Student's FCS Password

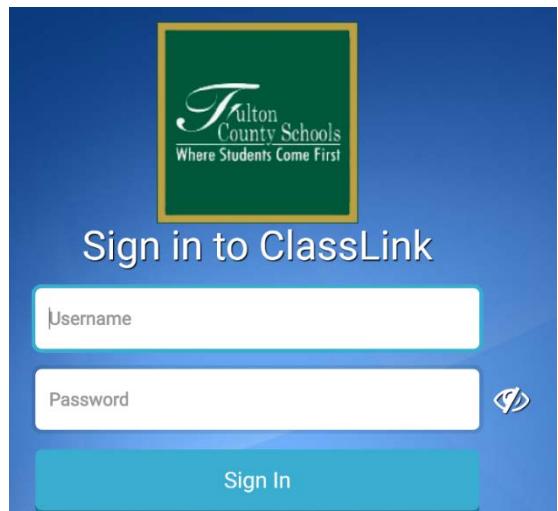


NOTE: The default password is student's date of birth without any special characters (mmddyyyy). However, students may have changed their own password. If the date of birth does not work, and you don't know the FCS password, you may contact the FCS Service Desk to request a password reset.

CLASSLINK LOG IN: USING A COMPUTER

If teachers ask students to login to SAFARI Montage from Classlink, students should:

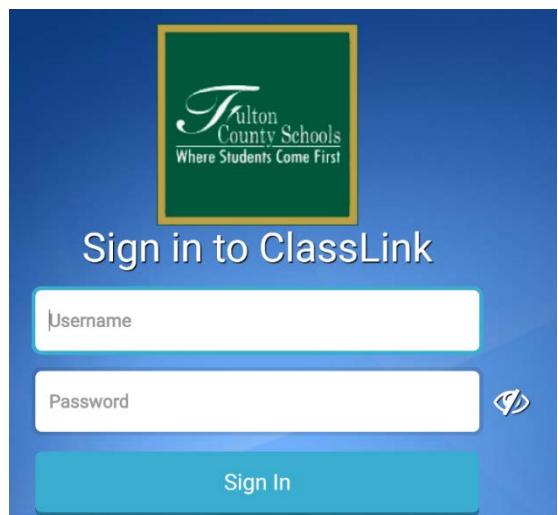
1. Go to <https://launchpad.classlink.com/fcs>
2. Enter your Fulton username (student ID#) and password. Click Sign In.
3. Once logged into ClassLink, click the SAFARI Montage icon.



CLASSLINK LOG IN: USING A MOBILE DEVICE

If teachers ask students to login to SAFARI Montage from ClassLink, students should:

1. On a mobile device download the **ClassLink** app from the store.
2. The first time you launch the app it will ask you for the name of the school district. Type **Fulton**.
3. Enter your Fulton username (student ID#) and password. Click Sign In.
4. Once logged into Classlink, click the SAFARI Montage icon.
