



KINDERGARTEN students have been hard at work this week! They learned how to retell a story using story elements, how to keep their bodies healthy by making healthy choices, and reviewed shapes and positional words. They also learned about Johnny Appleseed and the life cycle of an apple. They practiced their cutting and gluing skills by putting together this apple craft.

In FIRST GRADE we started our first science unit on Weather. We are tracking the weather daily and learning about tools for measuring the weather like a thermometer, rain gauge, and a wind vane. At home or in school, learning about types of precipitation really came to life with a fun science experiment where we made it rain in a cup! We also made a water cycle in a bag so we can observe the cycle up close. We love science!



MORNING CARPOOL PROCEDURES

How can you help? It's a list, but we can do it. You got this... We got this...

- Please have your child ready to exit the car when you pull up.
 - Explorers should be able to unbuckle their car seats and open and close the vehicle door all by themselves.
 - o Explorers should have all materials packed in their bags.
 - Explorers should be ready with their masks.
- Seat your child on the right-side seat of your vehicle so that they can get off quickly without holding up the line.
- Share your hugs, bye, bye and kisses before you reach the carpool loop.
- When in line try to pull in as close as you can to the vehicle in front of you while maintaining a safe distance.
- Please wait in line till the car in front of you moves. Overtaking and creating a second line within the carpool creates a hazardous situation for children exiting from the cars.
- If you are carpooling please go through the entire carpool. Do not let your children out of the car before the unloading zones (i.e. areas which are manning by the carpool staff).

What can I do if my child is not "ready to exit" while in the carpool loop?

- You can pull up front, beyond the first carpool team member and help your child; or...
- You can park in one of the six visitor parking spots and walk your child close to the building close to a Northwood team member.

What can I not do?

- Get off from the driver's side and assist your child during active carpool.
- Not park in the handicapped parking lots without the "handicapped" stickers. Roswell PD/Fire Marshall can issue a ticket to vehicles without "handicapped" stickers.
- Use your cell phone.
- Overtake another vehicle during active unloading.
- Please refrain from challenging our team members during active carpool. Feel free to call/email to share your concerns.
- Please do not engage our staff in a parent teacher conference during active carpool.
- Leave your child at the carpool circle and drive off after the bell has rung and the staff has gone inside.

Be a Buzzer Reader!

The Georgia Tech Women's Basketball team would like to invite your child to participate in their annual "Buzzer Readers" reading program. Buzzer Readers is an initiative to promote and encourage children to learn through reading. All elementary and middle school students from schools in Metro Atlanta are eligible to participate.

- Students have one month to read as many pages as they can from October 1-31st. Each child will record the number of pages read each day during the designated one month period.

- Parents may read to their children; however, group reading in a classroom setting are not to be counted.
