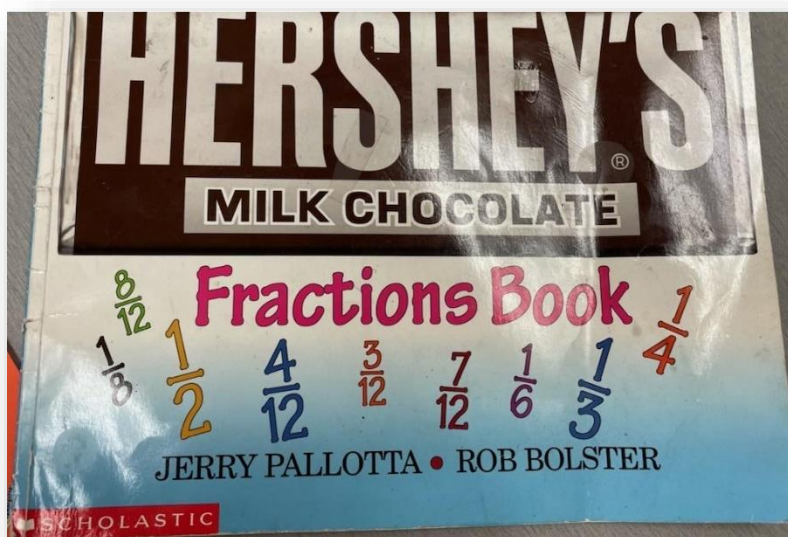

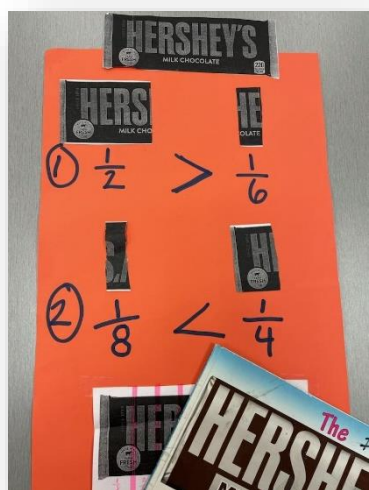

New Student Registration

New Student Registration Days for the 2021 – 2022 school year are **Wednesday, March 31 and Thursday, April 1**. Parents are encouraged to use the online enrollment application process to register online at their convenience. If your child is currently enrolled in Pre-K in Fulton County Schools you do not need to register your child.

K – 5 Registration

1. Complete the online registration process <https://www.fultonschools.org/enrollment>.
2. Email your application number to Mary Lou Fleming at flemingml@fultonschools.org.

If you do not have access to online registration, contact Mary Lou Fleming, flemingml@fultonschools.org to make an appointment for registration.

All documents will be reviewed and verified before completing the registration process.



Required Documentation

1. Certified Proof of Date of Birth (<https://www.fultonschools.org/Page/660>)
2. Original Social Security Card or Waiver Form (provided by school)
3. Current Immunization Record (GA Form 3231) Signed by Doctor
4. Certificate of Eye, Ear, Dental, Nutrition (GA Form 3300)
5. Government Issued Picture ID
6. Proof of Residency- Required to provide One Current Utility Proof AND One Residence Proof
7. Academic Record (if applicable)

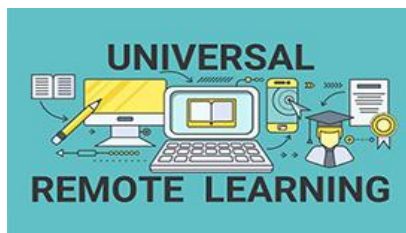

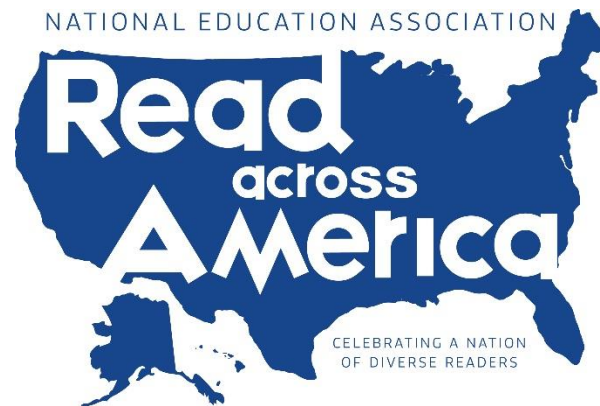
Parent (Student) COVID-19 Reporting Portal

The challenge: Design a creative bookmark that will encourage students to love books. Use a black sharpie marker. We will print it on colored paper.

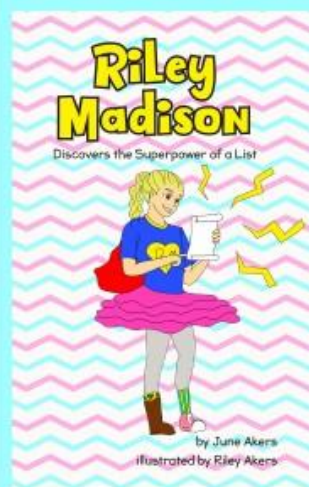
What to do: Design an award-winning bookmark in the space above using words or pictures.

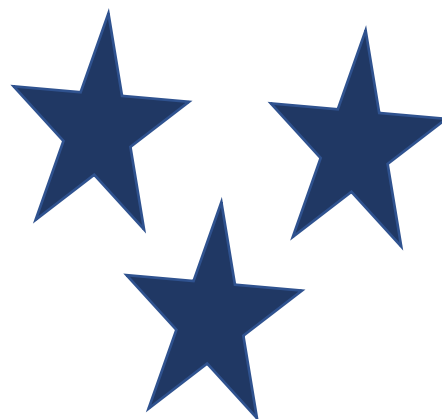
