


SECOND GRADE EXPLORERS

Some of the "cool" things we've been doing include using thermometers to measure the temperature of liquids. We learned that when thermal energy moves from a hot object to a cold object, this is called heat. We looked at the two scales used on thermometers: Celsius & Fahrenheit. 


