



Fulton County Library is pleased to announce the reopening of 32 branch libraries on Tuesday, May 4th, 2021, with in-branch services available on Tuesdays from 10 a.m. - 7 p.m. and Saturdays from 10 a.m. - 6 p.m. Patrons will have the opportunity to enter the library for in-person browsing and computer use.

Curbside services will remain available on Mondays and Wednesdays-Fridays, as previously offered. Visit <u>our website</u> for details on curbside services.

During in-person visits to the library, patrons will be permitted one hour per day of in-person browsing, self-serve checkout, pickup of holds, copying, printing and computer use. All services will follow CDC guidelines for social distancing and mask use. Patrons will be required to wear a mask (regardless of vaccination status) while inside the branch and maintain a 6 foot distance from staff and other patrons.
