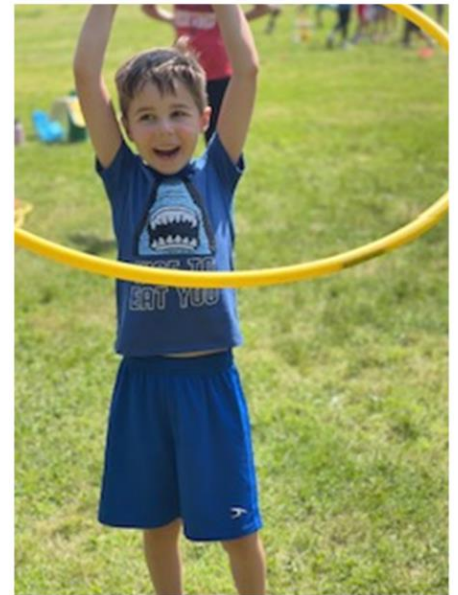

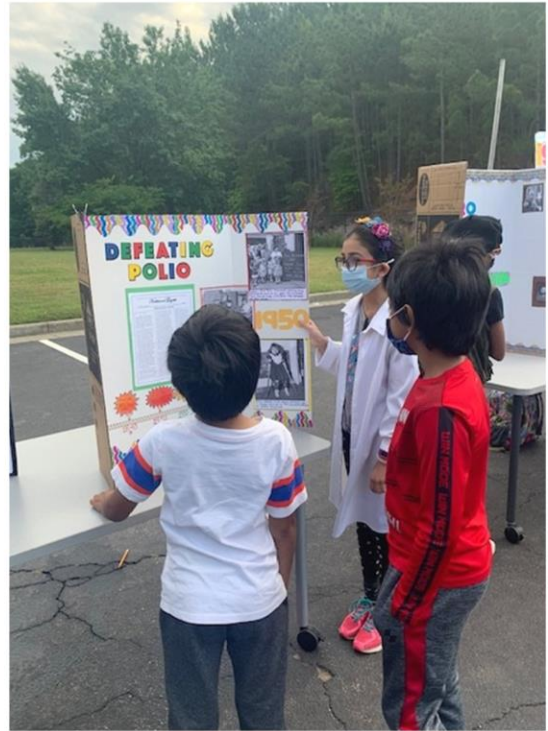

## KINDERGARTEN EXPLORERS

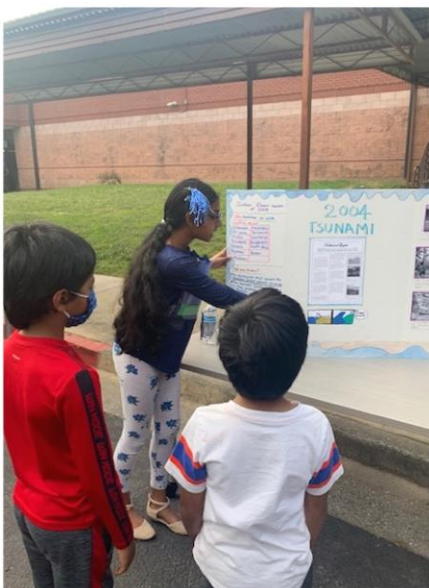

We are so proud of all of our 5<sup>th</sup> Graders!





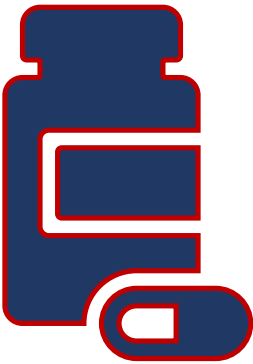
# END OF YEAR REMINDERS
