Book Fair eWallet* is a secure, cash-free way for students to shop the Fair.

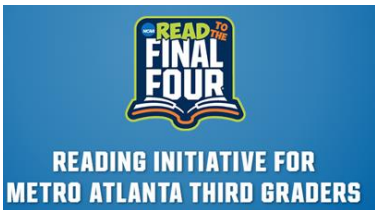
