

FULTON VIRTUAL PACING ALERT!

Due to the new implementation of the Canvas learning platform through FVS, students should be aware that pacing is more important than in the past. Students must take and pass DBAs in order to progress through the course, and it will not be possible to complete the course on time without proper pacing.

Here is a pacing estimate for the rest of the semester:

Students around 50%: Awesome! Keep up the pace

Students around 25%: Need to work around 1.5x the pace (1.5 hours/day) in the course

Students 0 – 15%: Need to pick up to around 2x the pace (2 hours/day)

Students should reach out to their Fulton Virtual teachers with questions or if they need assistance in the course.


