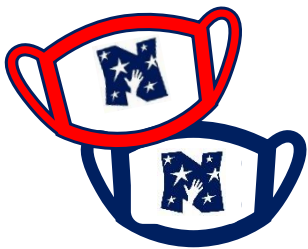

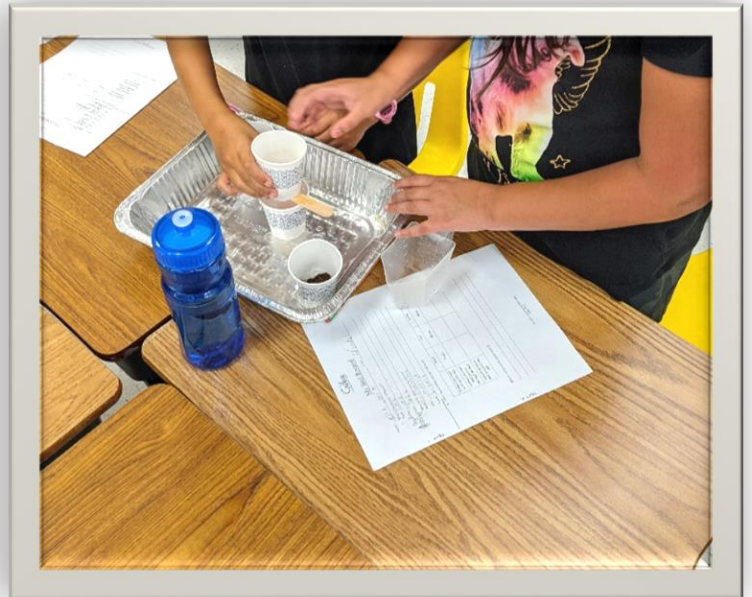
SECOND GRADE EXPLORERS
