- October 27: Deadline to meet with counselor to complete DE planning

- November 8: Gwinnett Tech DE application deadline

For students continuing DE in the spring:

- October 11: Georgia State schedule of classes available on PAWS
- October 25: Georgia State Registration begins
- November 9: Gwinnett Tech Registration begins

- Please remember that ALL DE students must book an advisement meeting (www.bit.ly/miltoncounseling) with their counselor before completing the funding application or registering for classes.

- All DE students MUST provide a copy of their college schedule to their counselor no later than January 4, or students will remain in their high school classes.

100th ANNIVERSARY ALUMI FEATURE

Drew and Natalie Pisano French are MHS graduates from the class of 2001. They met at Milton in Anatomy class where Drew convinced Natalie to hang out with his "crew," were high school sweethearts, went to the Prom together, went to UGA together, and married in 2006.

Drew and Natalie are now both business owners. Drew is founder and President of Your Pie Pizza and Natalie is the founder and owner of Tulip Magnolia Design, LLC, an art and design business. Natalie has a veterinary degree from UGA and is a licensed veterinarian but is not currently practicing. Instead she is raising two daughters, concentrating on her own business, renovating a 1940s Appalachian cabin in North Georgia for their new business Caper, and helping Drew with Your Pie. After Drew graduated from UGA in 2005 with a marketing degree, he worked for several years in the food business including a stint at UGA Dining Services before deciding to open his first Your Pie in Athens. Over the next thirteen years, they opened 76 more locations in 18 states. The Milton location of Your Pie is very close to their old

stomping grounds at the old Milton HS. He remembers his Home Economics teacher, Mrs. Sue Hampton, helped him “fall in love with cooking.”

At Milton, Drew and Natalie were both members of the Beta Club, FCA, Young Life, and the Interact Club (Drew was the President.) Drew was also in the Latin Club and a founding member of the Boys Lacrosse team in 2001. Natalie also rode as a competitive equestrian in the hunter/jumper discipline and showed throughout the Southeast, even though MHS didn’t have an equestrian team at that time.

They both have similar memories of their time at Milton High School. They have fond memories of football games and tailgates, Lake Windward boat rides, hanging out with their friends in parking lots, and visiting North Point Mall. They both remember Alpharetta as a small town with Phillips Variety Store, Alpha Soda, and the BP station. They remember it as a great place to grow up, very small and quiet—hence all the hanging out in parking lots.

Drew and Natalie each remember Milton preparing them well for life after high school. Drew said, “Milton was harder than UGA. I was well prepared to handle the schoolwork in college.” Natalie said, “I think MHS allowed me to succeed academically in college and professional school and it also provided a good balance of academics and social life.” Natalie and Drew love that they went to a big high school but had a close-knit community within it. They still have a strong group of high school friends that they remain in contact with. “The friends we made at Milton will last forever and the fact that our families still live in the area will always allow us to keep an eye out and support the Milton community for our lifetime.”
