PSAT/SAT DAY - 10.13.21

PLEASE SEE REMINDERS ABOUT THE PSAT/SAT DAY IN OCTOBER

- It will be an Early Release Day: dismissal at 12:45PM
- 12th graders do NOT report to school on 10/13/2021 **unless they signed up to take SAT School Day on this day.**
- All 9th through 11th graders are automatically registered to take PSAT on October 13, 2021. Fulton County schools pay for 9th and 11th grade test takers and the state of Georgia pays for 10th grade test takers.
- It is critical for all 9th, 10th, and 11th grade students to be in attendance on this testing day. We kindly request to consider NOT checking your child out of school for ANY reason during that day so they can complete the entire test.
- There are NO MAKE UP SESSIONS for the PSAT. So, if they do not finish their test in one setting, they will NOT receive a score.

The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT) is a great tool for students considering college. The PSAT/NMSQT measures critical reading skills, math problem-solving skills, and writing skills. Milton High School recommends that students take the PSAT/NMSQT in order to receive feedback about strengths and weaknesses, enter the competition for National Merit Scholar scholarships (11th graders) and to help prepare for the SAT.

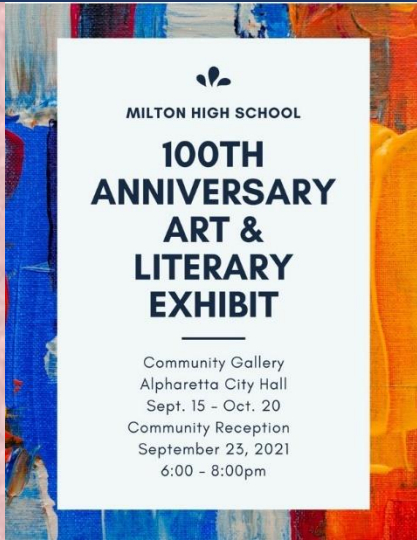

MHS 100th Anniversary Alumni Feature

Sarah Vautour, MHS Class of 2012, is an alumna of all three Milton cluster schools—elementary, middle, and high. At Milton, she was actively involved in chorus and singing. She was a member of the Select, Chorale, and Unaccompanied Minors singing groups. Her love of music was fostered by her family, including a strong influence by her maternal grandmother. Sarah attended multiple summer vocal programs throughout high school, including Boston Conservatory and Tanglewood, which crystallized her love of classical music and performance.

After Milton, Sarah received several scholarships to attend the University of Cincinnati College Conservatory of Music (CCM) where she received her undergraduate degree in vocal performance and then received a full scholarship to attend Rice University in Houston for her Masters in Vocal Performance. After completing her Masters, Sarah auditioned for and was accepted as a Domingo-Colburn-Stein Young Artist with the Los Angeles Opera. She made her professional and company debut in the Fall of 2018 as the Dew Fairy in Humperdinck's Hänsel and Gretel. In May 2019, Sarah made her Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra debut as the soprano soloist in Mahler's Das Klegende Lied with the Cincinnati May Festival Chorus and Maestro James Conlon. After finishing her tenure with the Los Angeles Opera in 2020, Sarah made her debut as Queen of the Night in Mozart's The Magic Flute at the summer 2021 Aspen Music Festival. She will be moving to Germany soon to make her European debut in December 2021. Sarah was inducted into Milton's Hall of Fame in 2019.
